WHOSE HEAD??

1.	Stop to centre of skull and stop to tip of nose equally balanced. Stop defined. Nose pure black.
2.	Rather small and flat, not too prominent or round in skull, nor too long in muzzle. Nose black.
3.	Short, fairly broad. Skull flat between ears. Well defined stop; short, strong muzzle. Head carried proud and high.
4.	Head long, narrow, skull flat, wedge-shaped without emphasis of cheek muscles, well filled up under eyes. Slight stop.
5.	Of moderate length, slightly shorter muzzle than skull. Moderately broad between ears; the skull flat without fullness between the eyes.
6.	Fairly small in proportion to body; domed forehead, broad brow; marked stop but not indented. Muzzle blunt, short. Distance between eyes and nose forms equal sided triangle.
7.	Well rounded skull, cheeks and jaws lean, muzzle moderately short, slightly pointed. Definite stop.
8.	Of medium length; relation of length of head to that of trunk is 3 : 7 Skull flat to very slightly rounded, broad. Stop moderately marked. Cheeks very flat, not prominent.
9.	Head relatively large, round, with no indentation of skull. Muzzle relatively short, blunt, square. Nose fairly large, open nostrils. Wrinkles on forehead clearly defined.
10.	Elongated. Narrow, without conspicuous cheeks. Skull flat. Muzzle rather strong and proportionate to skull.
