

Please note that the relevant document on the Dogs Queensland / ANKC Website has been amended where applicable;

ANKC Ltd Certificate - Lure Coursing

The Dogs Queensland Office now has a copies of the ANKC Ltd Lure Coursing Qualifying Certificate as a result of the decision at the last ANKC Ltd Board meeting to recognise this discipline.

Approval of National Show Application - NSW Samoyed Club

The ANKC are pleased to advise the approval of the 2016 National Show application received from the NSW Samoyed Club via Dogs NSW to be held on 3rd and 4th September 2016 at the Bill Spilstead Complex for Canine Affairs, 44 Luddenham Road, Orchard Hills, NSW.

Amendment to Fci Breed Standard - German Hunter Terrier

As a result of advice received from the FCI and after consultation with the National Breed Standards Coordination Group Chairperson Marie Merchant, the breed standard for the German Hunting Terrier will be amended as follows.

CURRENTLY READS:

Muzzle: Strong, distinct under jaw, slightly pronounced chin.

AMEND TO READ [Amendment underlined]:

Muzzle: Strong, <u>pronounced jaw-muscles and distinct lower jaw</u>, strongly pronounced chin.

CURRENTLY READS:

Eyes: Dark, small, oval, well placed in such a way that injury is hardly possible; the eyelids are tight. Resolute expression.

AMEND TO READ [Amendment underlined]:

Eyes: Dark, small, oval, <u>deep</u>; the eyelids are tight. Resolute expression.



CURRENTLY READS:

Forefeet: Often broader than the hind feet, the toes lying close to each other with sufficiently thick, hard, resistant and well pigmented pads. They are parallel in stance as well as in movement neither turned inward nor outward.

AMEND TO READ [Amendment underlined]:

Forefeet: Often broader than the hind feet, the <u>well closed</u> toes lying close to each other with sufficiently thick, hard, resistant and well pigmented pads. They are parallel, in stance as well as in movement neither turned inward nor outward.

CURRENTLY READS:

Hindfeet: Oval to round, the toes lying close to each other, with sufficiently thick, hard, resistant and well pigmented pads. They are parallel in stance and in movement neither turned inward nor outward.

AMEND TO READ [Amendment underlined]:

Hind feet: Oval to round, the <u>well closed</u> toes, with sufficiently thick, hard, resistant and well pigmented pads. They are parallel, in stance and in movement neither turned inward nor outward.

CURRENTLY READS:

Weight (desired ideal weight for working) Dogs - 9 to 10kg Bitches - 7.5 to 8.5 kg

AMEND TO READ [Amendment underlined]:

Weight:

Weight in males and females should be according to build, not too light nor too heavy.

CURRENTLY READS:

Faults: Any departure from the foregoing points should be considered a fault and the seriousness with which the fault should be regarded should be in exact proportion to its degree <u>and its</u> <u>effect upon the health and welfare of the dog.</u>

AMEND TO READ [Amendment underlined]:

FAULTS: Any departure from the foregoing points should be considered a fault and the seriousness with which the fault should be regarded should be in exact proportion to its degree and its effect upon the health and welfare of the dog and its ability to perform its traditional work.

CURRENTLY READS:

SERIOUS FAULTS: Splayed feet, cat feet.

AMEND TO READ [Amendment underlined]:

Splayed feet, cat feet, hare feet.

CURRENTLY READS:

DISQUALIFYING FAULTS: Over and undershot bite, wry mouth, pincer and partial pincer bite, irregulary placed teeth, missing teeth except for M3.

AMEND TO READ [Amendment underlined]:

Over- and undershot bite, wry mouth, pincer and partial pincer bite, <u>cross-bite</u>, irregularly placed teeth <u>in the upper and/or lower row of teeth</u>, missing teeth except for M3.

2016 Agility Rules - Clause 3.2.2 (Titles)

As a result of the Board endorsement of the 2015 National Agility Committee meeting minutes we refer all Member Bodies to the change in the Agility Rules Rule 3.2.2 relating to titles – refer extract from the amended rules which will be implemented from 1st January 2016 below:

"3.2.2 The Canine Control will receive application for the use of the relevant title letters after the name of each dog, when the dog has gained a qualification certificate at the following specified number of Trials under the specified number of Judges.

CLASS	NOVICE	EXCELLENT	MASTER	OPEN
Title	AD/JD	ADX/JDX	ADM/JDM	ADO/JDO
Number of Certificates	5	6	7	5
Number of Judges	3	3	3	

Multiplier suffixes for ADM/JDM may be awarded for multiples of seven certificates gained e.g. 21 ADM qualifications is equal to ADM 3.

Multiplier suffixes for ADO/JDO may be awarded for multiples of five certificates gained e.g. 15 ADO qualifications is equal to ADO 3.

Applications may be made for any multiplier suffix title without requiring applications for any predecessor suffixes i.e. an owner may apply directly for ADO7 without any requirement to apply and pay for ADO2, ADO3, ADO4, ADO5 and ADO6 titles

Multiplier suffixes only apply to certificates awarded after 1st July 2006."

The change to the rule is highlighted above in YELLOW and we understand is self-explanatory however if further clarification is required please let us know.

AMENDMENT TO KENNEL CLUB BREED STANDARD - SWEDISH **VALLHUND**

As a result of advice received from the Kennel Club (UK) and after consultation with the National Breed Standards Coordination Group Chairperson Marie Merchant, the breed standard for the Swedish Vallhund will be amended as follows.

CURRENTLY READS:

Colour: Steel grey, greyish/brown, greyish/yellow, reddish/yellow, reddish/brown with darker guard hairs on back, neck and sides of body, lighter hair same shade of colour as mentioned above is desirable on muzzle, throat, chest, belly, buttocks, feet and hocks. Instead of these lighter shades, white markings are acceptable, but never in excess of one-third of total colour.

AMEND TO READ:

Colour: Steel grey, greyish brown, greyish yellow, reddish yellow, reddish brown with darker quard hairs on back, neck, and sides of body. Lighter hair same shade of colour as mentioned above is desirable on muzzle, throat, chest, belly, buttocks, feet and hocks. Instead of these lighter shades, white markings are acceptable, but never in excess of one-third of total colour. Any colour other than the above, including white and blue or any non-standard colour, is highly undesirable.

We are currently arranging for the Breed Standard Extension (BSE) for this breed to be updated accordingly and this will be made available from our website once completed.

AMENDMENT TO BREED STANDARD - GORDON SETTER

As a result of advice received from the Kennel Club (UK) and after consultation with the National Breed Standards Coordination Group Chairperson Marie Merchant, the breed standard for the Gordon Setter will be amended as follows.

CURRENTLY READS:

Body: Moderate length, deep brisket, ribs well sprung. Back ribs deep. Loins wide, slightly arched. Chest not too broad.

AMEND TO READ:

Body: Moderate length. Level topline, deep brisket, ribs well sprung. Back ribs deep. Loins wide, slightly arched. Chest not too broad.

We are currently arranging for the Breed Standard Extension (BSE) for this breed to be updated accordingly and this will be made available from our website once completed.

Amendment To Regulations Part 6 - Clause 9.22

An anomaly in Regulations Part 6 Clause 9.22 relating to Breed Varieties - Judging & Interbreeding for the Xoloitzcuintle has been identified and after consultation with the National Breed Standards Coordination Group (NBSCG) Chairperson, Marie Merchant we confirm the following amendments to comply with current FCI General and Breed Specific Guidelines about Crosses of Breeds and Breed Varieties.

The amendments relate to Clause 9.22.2 and 9.22.3 and are highlighted below.

Clause 9.22 currently reads:

9.22 Xoloitzcuintle - Miniature: Xoloitzcuintle Hairless Dog - Intermediate: Xoloitzcuintle Hairless Dog - Standard: **Xoloitzcuintle Hairless Dog**

- 1. Judged separately with each variety receiving separate Challenge Certificates
- 2. Coated varieties can be bred from, under specified conditions, but must not be shown.
- 2.1 Coated Xoloitzcuintle breeding to a coated Xoloitzcuintle is NOT nermitted
- 2.2 Coated Xoloitzcuintle breeding stock must be the offspring of registered parents with at least three generations of Hairless to Hairless breeding. The Coated variety must be evaluated as a true breed at dog shows, to be able to be bred to Hairless dogs only. (Amended 04/15 to align with breed standard)

3. Inter variety breeding between the size type is NOT permitted.

- 4. Reclassified on size type is permitted under the following conditions: 4.1 Where a Xoloitzcuintle grows to a height 2 cm above the height as stated in the Standard for the Miniature and the Intermediate varieties it may be measured and re-registered within the actual size that the dog has achieved.
- 4.2 Three [3] licensed judges selected by ANKC Ltd shall carry out the measuring.
- 4.3 The three [3] judges shall be residents of the same State or Territory as that in, which the dog resides.
- 4.4 The measuring device used shall be that approved by ANKC Ltd.
- 4.5 Any challenge points awarded to the dog under the size of its original registration shall be cancelled, upon re-registration.
- 4.6 Xoloitzcuintle that are 2 cm under the size as stated in the standard are NOT Permitted to be reclassified and are to be moved to the Limited Register and Marked "Not to be upgraded and not eligible to be issued with an Export Certificate/Pedigree".

Clause 9.22 will be amended to read:

9.22 Xoloitzcuintle - Miniature: Xoloitzcuintle Hairless Dog - Intermediate: Xoloitzcuintle Hairless Dog - Standard: **Xoloitzcuintle Hairless Dog**

- 4.2 Three [3] licensed judges selected by ANKC Ltd shall carry out the measuring.
- 4.3 The three [3] judges shall be residents of the same State or Territory as that in, which the dog resides.
- 4.4 The measuring device used shall be that approved by ANKC Ltd.
- 4.5 Any challenge points awarded to the dog under the size of its original registration shall be cancelled, upon re-registration.
- 4.6 Xoloitzcuintle that are 2 cm under the size as stated in the standard are NOT Permitted to be reclassified and are to be moved to the Limited Register and Marked "Not to be upgraded and not eligible to be issued with an Export Certificate/Pedigree".

APPROVAL OF BOXER BREED STANDARD EXTENSION AND AMENDMENTS TO BREED STANDARD

The ANKC have endorsed the recommendation of the National Breed Standards Co-Ordination Group (NBSCG) that the BSE for the Boxer be approved, and the Breed Standard be amended as follows with the highlighted changes:

Ears:

Some American and Continental Boxers are cropped and are ineligible for competition under **ANKC Ltd Regulations.** The Boxer's natural ears are defined as: moderate in size (small rather than large), thin to the touch, set on wide apart at the highest points of the sides of the skull and lying flat and close to the cheek when in repose. When the dog is alert the ears should fall forward with a definite crease.

Tail:

Docked: Set on high and carried upward.

Undocked: Set on high and **carried upward**, of moderate thickness. In overall balance with the rest of the dog.



Matching Gundogs with People

Successful training of dogs requires matching the right dog with its handler and vice versa. That is why before choosing a dog with which you will spend the next ten years or more of your life, it is important that you carefully consider your own objectives and expectations.

Gundogs come in a variety of breeds, all with their own special breed characteristics. Furthermore, even within each of these breeds, there will be further varieties of temperament, athletic ability, biddability and ease of training. That is why any choice should be matched to the objectives of the owners as well as to significant others who will be involved in the dog's future life.

If a dog's future is to live in a home and be a companion to a family with differing ages with differing desires and expectations, then the choice will need to be different from one where only one person's expectations need to be considered.

If the dog is to spend a large percentage of its time in a small urban dwelling with only occasional visits to rural environments, then there are breeds with specific characteristics that would make them eminently more suitable to that environment, when compared to dogs bred and raised in kennelled rural environments and trained for only a specific type of work.

Therefore, before choosing a puppy, carefully look at your own personality and list exactly what your objectives will be in your relationship with your new dog. Then, and only then, carefully proceed with research of the breeds that best match your objectives.

Then finally search for a reputable breeder who has a history of breeding the type of dog that will increase your chances of being happily matched to your new canine partner.



RULES FOR THE CONDUCT OF QUEENSLAND DOG AND PUPPY OF THE YEAR COMPETITIONS IN 2015 / 2016

GENERAL RULES

- 1. The Queensland Dog and Puppy of the Year Competitions will be sponsored, promoted and run by Dogs Queensland, commencing on Tuesday, 1st September 2015 and ending on Wednesday, 31st August 2016. The Puppy of the Year Final will be judged on Friday 21st October 2016 starting at 6:30pm. The Dog of the Year Final will be judged on Saturday 22st October 2016 starting at 6:30pm. Both Finals will be conducted at the Dogs Queensland Showgrounds, 247 King Avenue, Durack as special events.
- 2. All finalists are requested to provide a high resolution photo (head study only), a photocopy of the registration of the exhibit and the name and date of the qualifying show for cataloguing prior to 28th September. All finalists will be contacted by the secretary of the Dog of the Year Committee.
- 3. The major prize for Dog of the Year is not transferable and will be awarded in the name of the Queensland resident owner/s of the winning exhibit. Where an exhibit is held in joint ownership with a current financial member of a recognised member body of the ANKC, that member must be financial as of 1st September 2015 up to and including 22nd October 2016.
- 4. The major prize for Puppy of the Year is determined by Sponsorship, varying from year to year. The major prize will be applied as for Dog of the Year, General Rules 3.
- **5.** Each Competition Finalist will receive a memento from the Dog of the Year Committee.
- **6.** Catalogues for the Competition Finals will be available for a fee.
- The Dog of the Year Committee reserves the right to alter any and all competition rules should it be deemed necessary, subject to the approval of the Dogs Queensland Board of Directors.
- **8.** The Committee is authorised to take steps to verify the eligibility of competition finalists. Should an exhibitor or exhibit not meet all the specified criteria for eligibility, the exhibit in question will not be permitted to compete in the Competition Finals.
- **9.** The Dogs Queensland Board of Directors is the final arbiter of disputed issues in respect to this competition and exhibitors acknowledge that, by entering this competition, they agree to be bound by the Rules and they further agree to indemnify Dogs Queensland against all claims arising from any and all actions associated with this competition.

ELIGIBILITY TO COMPETE

Dog of the Year

In order to qualify for Dog of the Year, the exhibit must reside in the State by 31^{st} May 2016, must remain resident in the State until 22^{nd} October 2016 and be registered to a Queensland member either solely or in partnership during this period (General Rules 3). (To reside means to physically live at the address on the Certificate of Registration. The term 'exhibitor' means owner/s, as recorded on the Certificate of Registration).

Puppy of the Year

To qualify for Puppy of the Year, the puppy must be registered to a Queensland member and resident either solely or in partnership (General Rules 3). The puppy is to remain in residence in Queensland from the time of qualifying until 22nd October 2016.

General

- (a) If a qualifying exhibit is transferred during the qualifying period, the award stays with the exhibit providing it continues to reside in Queensland.
- **(b)** Any exhibit leased/transferred out of Queensland in a qualifying year, or any exhibitor who moves Interstate or Overseas, automatically loses all entitlement to compete in the State Finals.

- (c) Any exhibitor who transfers to Queensland, permanently, from another Country / State will be eliqible to compete,
 - (i) providing they hold current membership of Dogs Queensland:
 - a) at their permanent Queensland address and
 - b) for the majority of the eligibility period (Refer to General Rules 1)
 - (ii) providing the exhibit is transferred to that Queensland address referred to in (i) for the majority of the eligibility period.

INFLIGIBILITY TO COMPETE

The purpose of this section is both to ensure fair and equitable competition for all entrants as well as to illustrate this fact to all of the dog world. In order to ensure equitable treatment for all potential exhibitors Dogs Queensland directs that its Board of Directors, Dog of the Year Committee, Major Sponsors and their employees and any other individual closely involved with the competitions or closely associated with persons involved with the competitions shall be excluded from entering at the discretion of the Dog of the Year Committee.

Therefore the following will be ineligible to compete in the Queensland Dog and Puppy of the Year Competitions in 2015/2016:

- (a) all Dogs Queensland Board members;
- (b) all Dog of the Year Committee members;
- (c) all employees of Dogs Queensland;
- (d) all Major Sponsors or any of their employees;
- (e) any person residing in the same household with any of those persons nominated in (a) to (d) above;
- (f) overseas or interstate exhibitors unless they are permitted to compete under these General Rules;
- (g) and any other individual closely involved with the competitions or closely associated with persons involved with the competitions.

Note: (g) will be at the discretion of the Dog of the Year Committee

Although not eligible to compete, recognition in the catalogue and acceptance of momenta for any qualifier owned by any members in (a) to (g) above is acceptable. The decision if any person nominated in (a) to (g) above should be excluded is to be decided upon the facts of each case with the final arbiter being the Dog of the Year Committee. In respect to (d) to (g) a person appealing to be allowed to enter may have to prove their standing by correspondence or such other evidence as is required from Major Sponsors, employers or such other appropriate persons

QUALIFICATION FOR ENTRY AS A FINALIST

- Any All Breeds Championship Show, Agricultural Show or Group Championship Show held in Queensland.
- 11. To qualify for Dog of the Year you have to win Best in Show or Runner Up Best in Show at any All Breeds Championship Show, Agricultural Show or Group Championship Show held in Queensland
- 12. To qualify for Puppy of the Year, you have to win Puppy in Show (from Puppy Class entry) or Minor Puppy in Show (from Minor Puppy Class entry) at any All Breeds Championship Show, Agricultural Show or Group Championship Show held in Queensland.
- 13. All rules under the General Rules apply.
- **14.** For cataloguing purposes, the following is required of the qualifying exhibit:
 - High resolution photo (head study only)
 - Photocopy of exhibit's registration
 - Owner's name
 - · Breed of exhibit
 - Date of Birth of exhibit
- **15.** The Dog of the Year Committee reserves all rights to include or exclude an exhibit which they feel does or does not meet any of the criteria listed within these Rules.
















Display Cabinet






This book unravels some of the obscure history of the breed and traces their development throughout the world. It also contains hints on training for the shooting field as well as trimming and grooming for the show ring.



The Welsh Springer Spaniel is distinguished from other spaniels by its medium size, unique head, vine shaped ears, and a rich red and white, lightly feathered coat.

They are active, inquisitive, loyal, playful and affectionate with all members of their family, an amiable dog who will work or play with other dogs and accept other household pets.


Their ever wagging tail expresses their joy for life. As they can be reserved with strangers, socialisation from a young age is recommended.

Bred to flush game in thick cover Welsh Springers are a sturdy dog with a keen nose giving them excellent tracking abilities. They give voice when they hunt and also when greeting your return, which ranges from a yodel to a bark.

They have a love of water and being wet; the ocean, river, dam or muddy puddle, even the water bowl, this however doesn't always extend to their bath; generally able swimmers and excellent retrievers.







Exercise

Although they enjoy home comforts they have a love of the outdoors and require regular daily exercise, preferably twice daily, and appreciate a run off leash in a safe area. They are happy chasing a Frisbee, ball or stick as well as snuffling and exploring in parks, around rivers and lakes. Without exercise to utilise their natural instincts, dogs become bored and create their own, often destructive means of keeping busy. Welsh Springers perform extremely well at dog sports such as agility and fly-ball as well as tracking and obedience.

The Welsh Springer is an extremely loyal and affectionate dog and sometimes referred to as a 'Velcro dog' due to their 'attachment' to their human companion. Hence some special 'time alone' sessions are essential in the upbringing of the young puppy to avoid future separation anxiety episodes. Once trained properly the Welshie becomes an adorable and ever-faithful companion.

Training

Being an intelligent breed, they are quick to learn and great problem solvers, sometimes known to have selective hearing, especially if there is something far more interesting to take their attention.

This needs to be kept in mind when training. Having a soft nature, they respond best to praise and reward, so clicker training and food reward will certainly speed up your efforts. Positive training that is stimulating and enjoyable will help produce an obedient and manageable dog on or off lead, starting at puppy stage with what you want as an adult. A naturally clean dog, they respond quickly to routine and house training, (allowing for the occasional accident for the excited puppy).

Basic Grooming

Welsh Springer Spaniels have a soft, silky coat which sits flat to the body and is only lighty feathered, making it easier than most coated breeds to maintain.

A regular brush and comb through of the feathering is required, and if they get wet and dirty, the dirt simply drops out as they dry. Bath or dry shampoo as necessary, and then use a coat conditioner, as this prevents problems with knots. For the family pet scissoring the hair of the feet level with the pads, trim hair between the toes and regularly clip the nails. Trim the feathering on the ears level with the shape of the ear, as they will reach the food bowl if left.

Due to the Welsh Springers' silkier coat there is definitely no need to use clippers on the coat. That will, in fact, destroy the self-cleaning property and attractive nature of the coat. Regular brushing is all that is needed to prevent knots and mats from forming in the undercoat. A more detailed trim is required for the show ring.

The Sussex Spaniel

This Breed first originated in Sussex U.K. and was once near extinction following Mr Fuller's death. Thanks to ROSEHILL line being famous, the gamekeeper bred on with a dog and bitch from that line last century.

Easily recognised by their flat silken golden liver coat and Seal fur across their muzzle on maturity they are a breed that exudes great character.

The Sussex is unusual in Spaniels, in that it gives tongue while on the game which can be an asset if the dog has gone into think cover. As beater dogs they do excellent work as they can face heavy thick cover and carry heavy game due to their strong necks.

They are strongly built with wide skull and pronounced stop which give protection to their eyes in thick cover. The neck is tough and strong allowing them to carry heavy game although retrieving is not the breed's strongest point.


The shoulders are long and are well laid back to enable short fore legs to reach forward to cover ground.

The rib cage is well developed to give the lung capacity, but the dog has no waist, just a wide muscular loin. The hindquarters are strongly boned to support their heavy weight of approx 25kg and they must be muscular. Sussex have a distinctive tolling gait rather like a drunken sailor when moving, giving the impression the legs are not attached to the body.

Basally the three L rule applies to this breed of long, low and level. Full of character, they are known as the downs of the Gundog in their nature and definitely NOT a breed who will allow others to dominate.

They are known to be very territorial. It is wise to be very firm with young Sussex to prevent them from becoming too full of themselves.

They demonstrate a wonderful temperament and with most people and their appealing movement, beautiful faces and character make them very fulfilling and amusing pets.









The Irish Water Spaniel

The Irish Water Spaniel is acknowledged to be a very old breed, but as is the case with so many Irish dogs and horses, it is impossible to separate fact from folklore, and the exact date of origin cannot be established.

It is believed to be a descendant of the old Portuguese Water Dogs and Spaniel root stock that came to Ireland from the Iberian Peninsula. The lineage can be traced back to the period, centuries ago, when the large and important Spaniel group was divided into the Land Spaniels and the Water Spaniels. The Water Spaniels included both the Irish and English varieties of water dogs.

The Irish Water Spaniel was developed in Ireland from two different strains that were in existence prior to the 1850s - the Southern County Water Spaniel and the Northern County Water Spaniel. Both were distinct types in size and colour, however today's Irish Water Spaniel more closely follows the Southern type.

By 1889 dog shows were providing a special class for Irish Water Spaniels. They were quickly adopted by both Irish and English sportsmen and their boldness and daring retrieves, extreme hardiness in the cold North Sea waters and superior disposition.

The earliest record of Irish Water Spaniels in Australia is 1891, although their breeding and where they came from is unknown. In the early sixties two dogs and two bitches were imported from New Zealand, and by the early 70s, registrations stood at 25.

Average size and lifespan:

Dogs: 53 - 58cms (21 - 23 ins) **Bitches:** 51 - 56cms (20 - 22 ins)


Lifespan: Irish Water Spaniels live between 10 to 12 years of age

Care requirements:

The coat with its crisp curls does not present the problem that might be expected, however it should be thoroughly combed with a wide toothed comb at least once a week. Eyes, ears and toenails should be checked regularly. A good swim or spray down will bring back those lovely curls.

Irish Water Spaniels do not shed loose hair and can therefore be recommended for people who may suffer from allergies associated with dog hair.

Irish Water Spaniels are very amenable to obedience training and have acquitted themselves extremely well in Obedience, Agility and Retrieving Trials throughout Australia.



Personality, characteristics and temperament:

Beneath its livery of brown curly ringlets, with topknot of twisted curls hanging down over its eyes, you will find a true Irishman - full of life, with a comical nature and great intelligence. The Irish Water Spaniel enjoys human companionship and will want to become one of the family. It is deeply affectionate to those it knows but can be reserved with strangers.






























Exquisite form The Clumber Spaniel

The Clumber Spaniel was developed by the Dukes of Newcastle and their gamekeepers, primarily the Mansell family. The breed takes its modern name from the Duke of Newcastle's Nottingham country estate of Clumber Park, which is now a National Trust property and lies in the north of the famous Sherwood Forest.

The Clumber was developed to support the Dukes and game keepers in hunting this and nearby estates which were usually covered in heavy timber and very heavy undergrowth littered with fallen branches and limbs. The white coat ensured he could be seen in most scrub, his build ensured he could penetrate into the depths of that scrub and flush game hiding there or even retrieve shot game.

Average size, weight and lifespan:

Dogs: 50cm (20 inches) in height at shoulder **Bitches:** 45cm (18 inches) in height at shoulder

Weight: 25 - 36 kg

Lifespan: 10 to 16 years of age (approx)

Ideal owners:

The Clumber is ideal for those with a little empathy with dogs, alert to a dog's body language and general health requirements, and essentially compassionate. The ideal owner will make sure the Clumber is exercised twice daily, groomed weekly, trimmed every eight weeks - whether the owner is tired or ill or in the peak of health themselves.

The ideal home will have a reasonably sized grassed backyard, with a smaller day yard set within the boundary. Parks or good walks will virtually be on the home's doorsteps; and be inviting and interesting to the dog and to the owner.

The Clumber has no problems adapting to being a house dog, but his health is best served if he can spend the days in a small outdoors yard (with appropriate bedding and shelter) and have a good romp through the whole garden under supervision.

Care requirements:

The Clumber Spaniel is one of the most low maintenance of the spaniel family. From about ten months of age they will need their feet trimmed every two months. From about twelve months of age the feathering under the ear hole and from the wrist to the foot on the front legs and from the hock to foot on the hind legs will also need to be trimmed every two months.







Personality, characteristics and temperament:

They have a deep seated desire to please their owner and the owner's family but cannot take the rigours of being forced trained or regimentally drilled; they need the opportunity and time to observe and assimilate how other dogs perform for their owners and will mimic this behaviour.

This heritage of working in the field is translated into a little independence, particularly when tracking, but they soon check their owner's whereabouts and will look to them for advice if the trail is clouded or lost.

The Cocker Spaniel

The Cocker Spaniel is a breed that was first mentioned 3000 years ago as existing in the Mediterranean countries. These 'long eared rabbit dogs' were observed in the Roman province of Spain and it is believed they were brought to England after the Roman conquest of Britain in approximately 56 BC.

They featured prominently both as working dogs and pets through the reigns of Henry VIII and the Stuart kings, being referred to as 'wood-cocking spaniels' - small dogs that could go through hedges and undergrowth to flush out the wood-cock.

The beginning of this century saw the formation of the Cocker Spaniel Club of England which drew up the early standard of the breed for shooters who needed a small, active, strong dog, sturdy enough to work cheerfully and tirelessly all day flushing or driving out the game.

Average size, weight and lifespan:

Dogs: 39 - 41cms (15.5 - 16 ins) approx at shoulder **Bitches:** 38 - 39cms (15 -15.5 ins) approx at shoulder **Lifespan:** Cocker Spaniels live between 12 to 16 years of age

Weight: 14 - 15kgs (28 - 32 lbs)

Personality, characteristics and temperament:

This fun loving, merry little dog makes a wonderful family friend and a devoted companion. It thrives on and needs the companionship of human beings.


Care requirements:

Requires regular grooming and particular attention should be paid to keeping the hair trimmed away from under and around the ears, the undercarriage and the feet.

The sturdy little Cocker can be housed indoors or out of doors and, providing the dog receives the love and attention it requires, it will happily settle for either situation.

If kept outdoors, the dog will require a suitable shed or kennel which is warm and draught-free in winter, cool in summer and weatherproof at all times.

If kept indoors, be aware that it will shed a little every day. The Cocker Spaniel is not a fussy eater and will eat almost anything. A narrow food bowl is recommended so that the long ears fall either side of the bowl and not in the food.



Ideal owners:

For those who understand the need for exercise and grooming.

The Field Spaniel

The Field Spaniel breed evolved about 150 years ago, developed in the English countryside. The Field is a true countryman. They are a very old breed, first known as the 'Black Spaniel' or 'Land Spaniel', but are now predominantly liver (brown) in colour, arising from crossing the Sussex Spaniel and after the Second World War with the English Springer Spaniel.

Whilst there is no proof in writing it is generally accepted that in the late 1800's there was Basset blood 'introduced' in to the breed (scenting ability). A NSW breeder reintroduced the Field Spaniel to Australia in 1989. The number of Field Spaniels are progressively increasing.

Average size, weight and lifespan:

Dogs: 46cms approx (18 ins approx) **Bitches:** 46cms approx (18 ins approx)

Lifespan: Field Spaniels live up to 12 to 15 years of age

Weight: 15.5 - 22.5kgs (35 - 50 lbs)


Personality, characteristics and temperament:

This is a breed for the energetic! They are active, tireless and inquisitive and can be noisy; of course if not fully occupied can be destructive. The Field Spaniel is a loving and sensitive breed that adores being with people and involved in all the household activity. The Field Spaniel requires firm and consistent training but never harsh training. They enjoy travelling and car rides.

Like most young gundogs they are very active (although quite sensitive), they need a great deal of time spent with them. They are not a breed that will take kindly to being put in a crate or kennel and ignored. Field Spaniels have a great deal of working instinct and are very enthusiastic when out with the gun. They are much faster than the Sussex, with great scenting powers and a natural ability to retrieve.

Field Spaniels coats should be silky but weatherproof, with feathering on legs, ears and tummy, they are easy to maintain with far less feathering than most Spaniels. Many bitches (and a few dogs) carry very little feathering, much to the frustration of their owners! It is quite uncommon to see a Field Spaniel as well furnished as a Springer or Cocker. The Field Spaniel can be solid black or liver (brown).

For the show ring the good ones are late starters, being immature at the puppy and junior stage but eventually turning to swans as their gawky frame fills out, they come up off their pasterns, the fronts tighten and the head matures into the noble edifice that is the hallmark of the breed. Let us hope it attracts patient and dedicated owners/breeders who are prepared to wait for the 'swan' to arrive.



Care requirements:

One of the largest of the Spaniels, the Field Spaniel needs quality feeding at regular hours. The Field Spaniel is easy to maintain, with the removal of excess hair from under the ear, around the feet and from the hocks is all that is required to keep the dog smart and neat, the coat requires just a daily brash/comb to keep it shining and healthy.

Ideal owners:

The Field Spaniel is an active dog and tireless worker. Their docile, affectionate and friendly nature makes it an excellent companion and family dog. However, it is very much a working spaniel and, as such does require daily exercise and patience.

THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT JUDGING ENGLISH SPRINGER SPANIELS

1 Size DOES matter. Got your attention? Good.

The breed standard uses words and phrases such as 'sturdy', 'muscular', 'strong', 'power' and 'every inch a sporting dog'. The standard sets specific height to weight parameters (i.e. a 20 inch tall dog, in good condition, will weigh approximately 50 pounds) and these parameters should be carefully considered when judging the breed.

A 20 inch tall dog that weighs 50 pounds will 'pick up heavy' (think of picking up a 50 pound bag of dog food). In many instances today, the breed is losing its sturdiness. Strong, but not excessively heavy, bone, properly shaped, oval ribs that carry well down to the elbow, broad, deep, muscular loins and wide, strong, well muscled upper and lower thighs have given way to over refinement, lack of rib, and excessively narrow loins and thighs, creating dogs that completely lack the correct weight requirement for their height.

While the breed should of course NEVER be coarse or cumbersome, it certainly is critical that it retain the characteristics that make it a strong, athletic, active and vigorous hunting dog that is able to 'go, and keep going, under difficult hunting conditions'.





Thanks to my buddy Elliott Weiss, for coining the phrase, 'they DO walk on their heads'. Just what does that phrase mean?

It means that while our breed may not be a 'head breed' such as the Collie or the Bulldog, every requirement in the head section of the standard is there for a REASON, and that reason is to help the dog fulfill its original purpose, that of finding, flushing and retrieving game.

They do walk on their heads when they hunt because they use their eyes, ears, nose, jaws, etc. to do their job, and the more correct the head construction, the better the dog will sight, scent and retrieve. Please read the extensive head section of our breed standard and make every effort to reward correct heads.

Look for things such as deep set, forward placed eyes, well developed eyebrows that are the highest point of the skull (the standard says FLAT on top, remember?), long, deep broad forefaces with strong under jaws, and parallel planes of the skull and foreface, with a nasal bone that is straight.

A correct front assembly is everything (well ok, almost everything!). The ESS standard calls for a WELL ANGULATED front assembly. Long sloping shoulder blades that come fairly close together at the tips, coupled with a long upper arm that sets the elbows well back under the dog. Ideally, the elbow should be under the tip of the shoulder blades and the neck and head should be out in front of that point.

Far too many dogs of this breed today stand with their elbows under their ears, totally lacking the length and angle of the bones of the front assembly that, when correct, give this breed its easy, free 'swing from the shoulder blade' gait. Think the word 'long' when judging this breed. No, not long cast, but LONG head, LONG neck, LONG sloping shoulder blades and upper arms.

- While we are on LONG, always remember that the English Springer Spaniel should be upstanding with a good amount of leg length. LONG legs. The breed should never be short legged or squatty. LONG ribcage and short loin are the correct combination of body properties for this breed, giving it the correct upstanding, short backed profile called for in the standard.
- Colour matters, markings don't.

The standard is very brief on this subject. Black and white, white and black, liver and white, white and liver, with or without ticking and/or roaning, with or without tan markings. That's it folks. There are NO preferred or required marking patterns in this breed.

Simply paint them all black (or white!) in your head and judge the DOGS, not the external trappings. You can LOVE the way a particular dog is marked, but youcannot AWARD the dog on the basis of its markings.


A few red or lemon dogs in this breed do exist, but I doubt you will ever see one in the ring. However if you do, please do not award it a ribbon.

6 Coat condition matters. Coat quantity really doesn't. Over the years, as in many other Sporting breeds, the ESS has been bred to grow more and more coat. It is not the amount of coat that is important, but the condition of the coat.

Some undercoat should be apparent, regardless of season or climate. Outer coat on the body should be firm and resilient, with a live, healthy glossy appearance.

The outer coat should lie flat to the ribcage, and it may be either straight or wavy. While the ESS should be 'nicely furnished' with feathering, an excessive amount is definitely not required.

The standard is specific on this point. Coat quality and condition are to take precedence over quantity.

7 Trimming. Where to begin? Again, as in many other breeds of show dogs, grooming and trimming in this country have advanced to quite an art form. Yet our standard states some specific requirements about trimming that should not be ignored by judges.

It is certainly legitimate to trim the breed in a manner that enhances a 'smart, functional appearance'. Above all, the final appearance should be NATURAL. Which means that the dog should look like its coat GREW that way, not like it was barbered into existence. Topcoats should have length to protect the dog from the elements when working; they should not be scissored off to an inch in length!

Outlines should be trimmed to give the dog an attractive, but natural silhouette, not trimmed with straight scissors like a paper cut out. Quote from the standard-'Overtrimming, especially the body coat, or any chopped, barbered or artificial effect is to be penalized in the show ring, as is excessive feathering that destroys the clean outline desirable in a sporting dog.'

Croups, tail sets and tail carriage. Now there's a mouthful! The only flushing spaniel that should carry its tail directly off the back with no slope to the croup is the Cocker Spaniel. Maybe I should say that again.

The only flushing spaniel that should carry its tail directly off the back with no slope to the croup is the Cocker Spaniel. The ESS croup should slope gently to the set on of the tail, and the tail should ideally be carried at 2-3 o'clock. Every other ESS breed standard in the world, except the North American ones, still calls for the tail to be 'set on low'.

Tails in North America have gradually migrated upward in both set and carriage for many years, with the result that the pelvic slope has been drastically reduced, opening the angle of the pelvis and femur and creating structure that places the rear feet of the dog far out behind a line dropped from the point of the buttocks, instead of placing the rear toes just behind that line.

The changes caused by this pelvic slope are not simply aesthetic; instead the results are rear legs that are not placed under the body at the correct point to support the dogs center of gravity and a change in movement from long steps on the ground to short steps on the ground with a lot of 'kick' in the air behind the dog.



The ESS is an efficient trotting dog, capable of utilising its legs at a trot for long periods of time on often difficult terrain when hunting. An efficient trotting dog is one that keeps its legs on the ground for long periods of each stride. Feet only work when they are on the ground, propelling the body forward with power and ease. There is far too much lift and kick seen in the breed today.

While it might LOOK fancy and long strided that sort of motion is totally incorrect because it expends far more energy than a stride that is long on the ground.

The ESS should swing its front legs forward from the shoulder blade, not pop them forward from the elbow. The only way this can be achieved is for the dog to have the correct length and angle of the bones of the front assembly. The hindquarter provides the forward propulsion, and the longer that the rear foot stays on the ground, accompanied by the forceful opening of the hip, stifle and hock joints, the easier and more efficient the gait will be.

Correctly built and muscled English Springer Spaniels should move freely and easily in a gait that seems effortless. The fast, choppy, short stepping motion, or the high lifting and kicking motion also all too often seen, are both incorrect.







Numbers 1 through nine above all come together in number 10, which is Silhouette and Proportion. These two things are critical in the English Springer Spaniel. A well proportioned dog, correctly built, properly angulated, free from exaggeration, with the right amount of bone and substance and the correct shape and length of head and neck, will present a clean, smooth, upstanding silhouette, combining the essential elements of both beauty and utility.




Figure 1, Correct Silhouette




Figure 2, Silhouette with many failings

The correct silhouette and proportion are what express the proper breed type of the individual dog. Always look for the outline that is represented in Figure 1 (below), and beware of the myriad of failings of the outline in Figure 2 (below), though the dog might at first strike you as eye catching or fancy.

The breed should carry its correct, upstanding outline and proportion when it moves. The head will (and should be allowed to, by the handler) go somewhat forward to assist in balance, but the dog should never sink to the ground or appear low in action.


The day certainly met its objectives of engaging community members and their dogs, and raising money for the Guide Dogs – with in excess of \$500 being raised.














