



## President's message for October 2015

The last few months have proven to be a very disruptive and unsettled time for our organisation. The circulation of petitions, trials by social media and the spreading of slanderous lies across the internet have consumed not only a large amount of the Board's time and resources, but also the time and resources of the office. Personally, I am left sitting here wondering what purpose have all of these things served, as I can see no credible or constructive purpose for any of it. If anything, these constant pot shots at the Board and the office are diverting our time away from much needed activities such as the progression of camping facilities at Durack, the development of a formal business plan for our organisation, and the proposed move of the office to Durack.

Whilst some members may disagree with the cancellation of the recently called Special General Meeting, I can assure all members, that legal advice was sought, and due to the removal of signatures from the petitions, the petitions became invalid. As such, no legal basis for the continuation of the Special General Meeting existed.

Members should be aware that the Constitution and Rules Reform Committee will now look at the issues addressed in the first petition, which related to the election of a President by the members, as opposed to the appointed Board of Directors. The Constitution and Rules Reform Committee has been created for all members to utilise. Before any changes or amendments are put through, proper consultation will occur with Clubs and members. Constitutional amendments can not occur without the proper process of being adopted at an appropriately called Special General Meeting, or at the organisation's Annual General Meeting.

The second petition raised dealt with a vote of no confidence in a current Director of our Board. Motions on votes of no confidence are very serious matters and should never be taken lightly. A person's dislike or contempt for a Director should play no part in such motions. The members are given the right to vote for those candidates that they wish to occupy the Directors' positions every two years. If members believe a Director should not continue on, that is the time they should vote them out. If any Director acts in a manner which is in breach of the law, or contradicts their fiduciary duties as a Company Director, the Board will act to remove such person. Votes of no confidence should only stem from matters of a very serious nature and should be able to be listed out, so that they can be replied to in accordance with the law.

There seems to be a great deal of gossip and untruths being aired at events and across social media. Despite gossip which has currently been circulating, the Directors of Dogs Queensland are all volunteers. None are remunerated in any way.

An item which recently appeared on social media made allegations of a Director spending \$100,000 of Dogs Queensland funds which did not need to be spent and other members of the Board were kept in the dark. This allegation is reprehensible and absolutely absurd. The circulation of this sort of nonsense needs to stop. The Board will be looking to introduce a 'social media policy' over the coming weeks, to make it very clear to all members what is acceptable and what isn't. All members should take the time to read this policy once it is released and ensure they follow the provisions set down.

#### **UPDATE ON CAMPING**

On Thursday 17th September, Board and member representatives met with representatives of Brisbane City Council in relation to the next stage of allowing RV and Caravan Camping on the Durack grounds. As a result of this very productive meeting, the Board will now move ahead with the development application approval that will allow 51 sites for all forms of Camping. It is envisaged that this approval will take 3 - 6 months and cost in the region of \$50,000, which includes mandatory Brisbane City Council fees, Town Planners fees, compulsory Bushland Survey fees and some required landfill.

#### DOG AND PUPPY OF THE YEAR

As members would be well aware by now, the Puppy and Dog of the Year events for 2015 have been moved from Durack to the RNA grounds, due to the limited camping facilities available at Durack for these events. Camping and access for RVs and caravans will be permitted at the RNA grounds and the events will be conducted in the same area where this year's Brisbane Royal (EKKA) was held. Holding the event at the RNA will not cost Dogs Queensland any more than it would do at Durack, the RNA has most of the items required for the event in situ and hiring costs will be significantly decreased. The decision to move our premier event of the year was a difficult decision to make. However, the move will benefit the majority of our members by providing camping and under cover facilities for the events to be run. I hope all members will pull together to continue to make this a truly special event.

#### **Christmas Office Closure**

All Members are asked to please note that the Dogs Queensland Office will be closed for the Christmas Holidays from 12:00pm on Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> December 2015 and will reopen on Monday 4<sup>th</sup> January 2016.

#### **Durack Fun Days**

For 2016, Clubs using Durack for 'Fun days' or similar events will only be allowed to do so twice a year. The dates for 2016 will be Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> May and Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> November.

#### **Fees**

The preparation of the 2016 Budget is an important function as ultimately the budget determines the level of increase necessary in respect to our fees and charges and in this way affects all members. The budget policy of containing increases in fees and charges to a minimum has been maintained in 2016.

## APPROVAL OF ELECTRONIC MOTION #119 - RECOGNITION OF NEW BREED: ESTRELA MOUNTAIN DOG

In accordance with the approved motion, this breed will be eligible for exhibition from 1 July 2016 in Group 6 (Utility).

#### AMENDMENT TO SHIBA INU BREED STANDARD - CORRECTION

There is an error in the Shiba Inu breed standard, the breed standard for the Shiba Inu will be amended as follows:

#### **CURRENTLY READS:**

Forequarters: Shoulders moderately sloping, elbows tight, seen from the forearms straight.

## TO BE AMENDED TO READ AS PER THE FCI BREED STANDARD WHICH STATES:

Forequarters:

General appearance: Seen from the front, forelegs straight.

Shoulders: Shoulder blade moderately sloping.

Elbows: Tight.

#### AMENDMENT TO BREED STANDARD - CANADIAN ESKIMO DOG

The breed standard of the Canadian Eskimo Dog has been amended to bring it in line with the Canadian Kennel Club breed standard which ANKC currently uses:

#### **CURRENTLY READS:**

Colour:

(b) White body with only the smallest amount of red, buff (including cinnamon shades), grey or black around the ears;

(e) Red body or buff body or cinnamon body with white on the chest or legs and underside of the body;

## TO BE AMENDED TO READ AS PER THE CKC BREED STANDARD WHICH STATES:

(b) White body with only the smallest amount of red, buff (including cinnamon shades), grey or black around the ears or eyes.

(e) Red body or buff body or cinnamon body with white on chest and/or legs and underside of body.

#### AMENDMENT TO BREED STANDARD - PYRENEAN MASTIFF

The Pyrenean Mastiff breed standard has been amended in the 'General Appearance' section to bring it in line with the FCI breed standard which ANKC currently uses:

IMPORTANT PROPORTIONS: Within medium proportions.

- · Well balanced and harmonious over. The length of the body measures barely more than the height at withers.
- · Length of skull in relation to bridge of nose = 5:4.
- · Breadth of skull: Equal to or slightly larger than length.
- $\cdot$  Relationship of height at withers to girth of chest is approximately 7:10.

#### AMENDMENT TO BREED STANDARD - CANE CORSO

The Cane Corso breed standard has been amended to bring it into line with the FCI breed standard which ANKC currently uses:

#### **CURRENTLY READS:**

Body: The body is somewhat longer than the height at the withers. The Corso is sturdily built but not squat.

## TO BE AMENDED TO READ AS PER THE FCI BREED STANDARD WHICH STATES:

BODY: The body is somewhat longer than the height at the withers. Sturdily built, but not squat.

Withers: Pronounced, rising above the level of the croup.

Back: Rectilinear, very muscular and firm.

Loins: Short and strong.

Croup: Long, wide, slightly inclined.

Chest: Well developed in three dimensions, reaches to the elbow.

#### **RULE AMENDMENTS**

The following Rules have been amended as a result of decision made by ANKC and are included in the amendments document on the Dogs Queensland Website;

Amended 6.2.4

**6.2.4** Special Conditions for Registration of Certain Breeds (Amended 04/15 EAP)

(i) Effective from 3 June 2014, White Boxer:

White Boxers can only be registered on the Limited Register flagged not to be upgraded, and a White Boxer imported into Australia cannot be registered on any register. (05/05) (Amended 06/14 EAP) [Note: Prior to the 3 June 2014 (06/14 EAP amendment) the registration of White Boxers is NOT permitted on any register.] (Amended 10/14 EAP)

(ii) Effective from 1 January 2015, Border Collie, Dachshund and Shetland Sheepdog:

Merle to Merle and Dapple to Dapple matings are prohibited. The Merle or Dapple gene carries an increased risk of impaired hearing and sight problems. Any breach of the regulation will constitute an offence by the Member/Members who are the owners of the Sire and Dam of the litter. Any puppies resulting from such matings will be placed on the Limited Register and endorsed never to be upgraded. (05/05) (Amended 06/14 EAP) (Amended 10/14, 7.5.9)

(iii) Effective from 1 January 2015, Chihuahua:

'Merle' Chihuahuas can only be registered on the Limited Register, flagged "not to be upgraded", and a 'Merle' Chihuahua imported into Australia cannot be registered on any register. (05/05) (Amended 06/14 EAP) [Note: Prior to the 1 January 2015 (06/14 EAP amendment) no 'Merle' Chihuahuas can be registered on any register and a 'Merle' Chihuahua imported into Australia cannot be registered on any register.]

- (iv) The word "dapple" must not be used in isolation, but used in association with a colour, i.e. "red dapple", "chocolate dapple" or "silver dapple" only.
- (v) Effective from 1 January 2015, Pug: 'Brindle' Pugs can be registered on the Limited Register and flagged "not to be upgraded" and a 'Brindle' Pug imported into

(v) Australia cannot be registered on any register. (10/07, 6.2.6) (Amended 06/14 EAP) [Note: Prior to the 1 January 2015 (06/14 EAP amendment) no 'Brindle' Pug can be registered on any register and a 'Brindle' Pug imported into Australia cannot be registered on any register.]

(vi) Effective from 1 January 2015, Weimaraner:

The colour "Blue" is not to be recognised as an allowable colour for Weimaraners and can only be registered on the Limited Register, flagged "not to be upgraded" (10/10, 8.1) (Amended 06/14 EAP) [Note: Prior to the 1 January 2015 (06/14 EAP amendment) the colour 'Blue' is not to be recognized as an allowable colour for Weimaraners.]

(vii) Effective from 1 July 2015, British Bulldog: Black, Black & Tan, Dudley, or Bulldogs showing marked variation from those listed in the Breed Standard, (Including those registered in other Countries) can only be registered on the Limited Register, flagged "not to be upgraded". (Added 04/15 EAP).

Added 8.6 then Renumbered Old 8.6 - 8.17 to become 8.7 - 8.18

**8.6** Colour Breedings – (Added 10/14, 7.5.9)

The following 'colour' breedings are not permitted for health reasons:

Border Collie – merle to merle Dachshunds – dapple to dapple Shetland Sheepdogs – merle to merle

Any breach of this regulation will constitute an offence by the member/members who are the owners of the sire and dam of the litter. The progeny resulting from such a breach will be registered on the Limited Register and endorsed 'never to be upgraded' and any further penalties may be determined by the member's member body.

8.7 Coat Inheritance Factors – Chihuahua

Long Coat x Long Coat – all offspring will be long coat. No other option is possible because to be a long coat phenotype no smooth coat dominant genes can be present.

Smooth Coat x Smooth Coat – the proportion of offspring will vary from 75% smooth/25% long to 100% smooth depending on whether or not any of the parents is carrying the recessive long coat gene.

Long Coat x Smooth Coat – the proportion of offspring will vary from 100% smooth coat to 50/50 depending on whether or not the smooth parent is carrying the long coat gene or not.

#### **8.8** German Shepherd Dog

Effective 16.10.2005 litters, resulting from the mating of German Shepherd dogs under the age of 18 months (either the Sire or Dam) at the time of mating, are eligible to be registered on the Limited Register only and flagged 'NOT TO BE UPGRADED'. (Amended 10/07, 6.3.1)

#### **8.9** German Shepherd Dog

For all German Shepherd litters born after 1.1.99 and where the parents have been born after 1.1.97, these parents must show results of X-rays for hips and elbows, and a Haemophilia A result for the males, as defined below:

Effective September 1, 2004, the following requirements will apply: -

- All imported GSD males must have an Australian H.Neg certificate prior to ANY progeny being registered in Australia.
- 2. All sons of imported GSD bitches must be in possession of an H.Neg certificate prior to ANY of their progeny being registered in Australia.
- 3. All GSD males born from litters imported in whelp must be in possession of an H.Neg certificate prior to ANY of their progeny being registered in Australia.
- 4. Where a GSD bitch is sired by imported semen, any of her male offspring must have an H.Neg. Certificate prior to any of his progeny being registered in Australia. (05/04)

#### 8.10 For all German Shepherd litters born from 1 June 2011:-

 Both parents of every litter must be screened for Hip Dysplasia through an official Hip Dysplasia Control Scheme.

Where the parents have been born after 1.1.10, they must record a score of no more than 12 on either hip, or in the case of imported animals, a grading that is deemed to be acceptable for breeding in their country of origin.

2. Both parents of every litter must be screened for Elbow Dysplasia through an official Elbow Dysplasia Control Scheme. Where the parents have been born after the 1.1.10, they must record a grading of Normal, Grade One or Grade Two on both elbows, and be free from the condition of UAP (Ununited Anconeal Process). Breeders of litters whelped on or after 1 June 2011,

 will be required to comply as a prerequisite to registration of any litter on the ANKC Main Register. Dogs must be positively identified by microchip, or tattoo prior to being x-rayed. Litters which do not meet the above requirements will be placed on the Limited Register and will be flagged not to be upgraded. (01/11)

#### 8.11 Rottweiler

For litters of Rottweilers born where the parents have been born after 1.1.97, these parents must show results of X-rays for hips and elbows. (Amended 10/13 – 5.6.4)

#### **8.12** Bedlington Terrier

Litters will be eligible for registration on the Main Register only if both parents have been tested for Copper Toxicosis.

#### **8.13** Australian Shepherd

All Australian Shepherd litters, where the parents have been born after 1st July, 2001, these parents must be radiographed and assessed for Hip Dysplasia as a prerequisite to registration of any litters. (05/01) (Amended 10/13 – 5.6.4)

#### **8.14** Labrador Retriever

Breeders will now be required to have parents of all litters radiographed and assessed for the diseases (hip and elbow dysplasia) as a prerequisite to registration of any litter. Any parent whelped before October 1st, 1997 may be excluded. (05/03, Amended 10/13 – 5.6.4)

#### 8.15 Golden Retriever

Breeders will be required to have parents of all litters, where the parents themselves were whelped on or after 1st January, 2002, radiographed and assessed for Hip Dysplasia as a prerequisite to registration of any litter. (10/01).

#### 8.16 Bullmastiff

Effective 01.01.2008 litters resulting from the mating of Bullmastiffs where the dam is under the age of 18 months at the time of mating, are eligible to be registered on the Limited Register only and flagged 'NOT TO BE UPGRADED'. (10/07, 6.3.1)

- **8.17** For all Bullmastiff litters born after 1 January 2013, the following will apply:
  - 1.1 Both parents of every litter must be screened for Hip Dysplasia through an official Hip Dysplasia Control Scheme where the parents have been born after 1 June 2011.

1.2 Both parents of every litter must be screened for Elbow Dysplasia through an official Elbow Dysplasia Control Scheme where the parents have been born after 1 June 2011.

Where either or both parents were born after the 1 July 2011, those parents/parent will be required to comply as a prerequisite to registration of any Bullmastiff litter on the ANKC Ltd Register main or limited to the above screening. Dogs must be positively identified by microchip or tattoo prior to being x-rayed. Results of these assessments must be submitted at time of litter registration. Litters which do not meet the above requirements will not be registered.

[Clause 8.16 does not affect dogs born prior to 1 July 2011, nor semen collected and stored prior to 1 July 2012 in Australia.] (10/12)

#### **8.18** Flat Coated Retriever

- 8.18.1 Effective from 1 March, 2009 breeders of litters whelped on or after this date will be required to comply as a prerequisite to registration of any litter. Any parent whelped before 1 January 2002 is exempted. Dogs must be positively identified, preferably by microchip, prior to being tested. (10/08)
- 8.18.2 Glaucoma to be designated as a problem in the breed and for Litter Registration Limitations to apply requiring that both parents must be assessed as clear of Glaucoma;
- 8.18.3 Hip Dysplasia to be designated as a problem in the breed and for Litter Registration Limitations to apply requiring that both parents have been radio graphed and assessed for Hip Dysplasia;

Elbow Dysplasia to be designated as a problem in the breed and for Litter Registration Limitations to apply requiring that both parents have been radio graphed and assessed for Elbow Dysplasia.

#### **9.11** Amended 9.11

Belgian Shepherd Dog (Groenendael); Belgian Shepherd Dog (Laekenois); Belgian Shepherd Dog (Malinois) & Belgian Shepherd Dog (Tervueren). Effective from 1st February, 2016 the Inter variety mating of Belgian Shepherd Dogs shall only be conducted if they have been approved by ANKC in accordance with FCI breeding requirements, and the submission for the Intervariety mating has been received by ANKC at least 6 months prior to the proposed mating. The only allowable submissions for Intervariety matings are:

Groenendael to Tervueren, Tervueren to Malinois, Laekenois to Malinois And the pedigree of both the Sire and Dam must be 3 generations clear for the variety. (10/12, 7.2.1) (Amended 10/14, 7.2.2) (Amended EM#111, 06/15)

# Obedience News – Annual Awards

The annual presentation of Championship title trophies, individual Dog of the Year Awards, and Club Shields is always a fun night and it's coming around again on Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> January 2016, commencing at 5:00pm.

#### **DOG OBEDIENCE / TRAINING CLUB SHIELDS**

#### 1. General Rules

The following rules apply to both the Club Shield competitions listed below.

- 1.1 Award year: Scores claimed must have been Qualifying scores gained within the period 1 November 2014 to 31 October 2015 (referred to below as the 'qualifying period'). (Note: This is different from the calendar year qualifying period for the individual awards.)
- **1.2 Eligible Clubs:** Only Clubs affiliated with the Canine Control Council (Qld) [CCC(Q)] are eligible to compete for these awards.
- **1.3 Eligible results:** Only results from Obedience and Tracking trials (including breed specific Trials but excluding Track and Search trials) held in Zone 1, Queensland, during the qualifying period shall be eligible to be counted.

Results shall only be allocated to a Club if the competitor nominated that Club on their entry form or prior to the commencement of the Trial, and the Trial Secretary assigned that Club nomination on the catalogue submitted to Dogs Queensland following conclusion of the Trial.

Where points are claimed on the basis of Titles gained, photocopies of the relevant Title Certificate or (where the Title Certificate has not yet been issued) all relevant Qualifying Certificates must be provided by the Club claiming those points. If the official date of the Title Certificate, when issued, is in the next qualifying period, it will be removed from calculation of the Club's score.

- **1.4 Closing date:** The closing date by which Clubs must submit details of members' eligible results is two weeks after the end of the qualifying period, viz 16 November 2015.
- 1.5 The Obedience and Rally Obedience Club Shields are perpetual trophies and must be returned each year prior to the annual presentation event.

#### 2. Obedience

#### 2.1 Norm Claridge Shield

- 2.1.1 This Shield was established in memory of Norm Claridge who, together with Ray Underwood and Bert Halton, was instrumental in and committed to establishing and improving the sport of, and good sportsmanship within, all breeds dog obedience under the aegis of the CCC(Q).
- **2.1.2** The award is based on the highest aggregate of points achieved by a Club, allocated in accordance with section 2.1.3 below.

This year, the Puppy of the Year Competition is taking on a much more 'relaxed' vibe. The Committee has decided that there will be no allocated seating and, in fact, ringside seating will be at no cost. A light canteen will be operating all night and further details of the food on offer will be forthcoming closer to the event.

#### **Dress and Attire**

Last year, it was so pleasing to see all of the spectacular outfits (dresses, evening gowns, dinner suits etc) that were worn by those in attendance. I would like to thank everyone for really getting into the spirit of the occasion.

Similarly, in 2015, the dress standard for the Dog of the Year Final is again Formal wear (black tie) with Semi-formal attire (business suit) also being acceptable. Male patrons, exhibitors and onlookers are expected to wear at the minimum a suit or sports-jacket with tie. Bow tie is preferred. Female patrons are expected to wear a suitable evening dress and/or show suit or cocktail dress.

The dress standard for the 2015 Puppy of the Year Final is, this year, much more relaxed. #### **Ring Setup**

Unlike previous years, the rings (and also parking/grooming area) this year will be totally under cover at the RNA Grounds - occupying the space used for the Canine exhibition during the Royal Show (EKKA).

Two rings will operate simultaneously with the Judge's names being drawn at random. If time permits, the two rings will then be combined into one much larger ring in the later rounds.

The ring surface itself will be a combination of concrete and carpet. However, when moving, exhibitors/exhibits will be running on carpet only.

Tables will be set up around the rings for those who have purchased dinner and ring side seating. Dinner/ringside seating bookings are strongly encouraged. However, there will also be a smaller area allocated for persons who do not wish to purchase ring side seating (your own chairs will be required for this area).




Chesapeake Bay Retriever by Stacy Kennedy is a TFH Publication and the only book currently available – full of glossy photos, this book covers the basic history of the breed, standard and retrieving abilities.

For the Curly Coat, I would like to mention two books on this breed - *The Curly Coated Retriever* by Audrey Nicholls and *The First Curly Coated Retriever Book of Champions 1860-199. The Book of Champions* contains details of all champions including Show Champions, Field Trial Champions and Influential Untitled Dogs. Each dog has photo and pedigree details. The book we have is #0338 of a Limited Edition of 1000 copies.

Flat-Coated Retrievers Today by Joan Mason is another beautifully illustrated book and contains every aspect of the breed – history, breeding, showing and working. 

### 'The Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retriever'

The 'Foreword' of this book was written by James B. Spencer 'Retriever' columnist of 'Gun Dog Magazine' and if you read only this Foreword you get an amazing insight into this breed and the people who wrote the book. Like all speciality breed books, this covers the history of the breed from 'the unique little red dog commonly called Tollers' to its development and Maritime connections. Tolling in a hunting context is a word that means to entice or lure game.


Tolling is described in this book as follows:-

"The tolling dog runs, jumps and plays along the shoreline in full view of a flock of ducks or geese. The dog occasionally disappears, then reappears, arousing the curiosity of the birds who come into investigate and thus lured within gunshot range. The Toller is Subsequently sent out to retrieve downed birds."

The Toller was first recognised by the Canadian Kennel Club in 1945. A committee was formed in 1979 to revise the CKC Standard and the resulting version came into effect in 1982. With the acceptance of that revised standard the Toller was accepted into the FCI. A full chapter in the book takes an in-depth look at the standard.

A poem published in the book called 'Tollers Love' has the opening lines just about sums it all up:-

"There are days you just have so much love you're unable to show. As you watch your Toller puppy and its face is all aglow. Aglow with learning, head cocked to see and hear ears erect with wonder, another mystery made clear"

# The Chesapeake Bay Retriever

Plucked from a shipwreck more than 200 years ago, the water-loving Chesapeake Bay Retriever remains a devoted companion.

As its webbed feet will attest, the Chesapeake Bay Retriever is a breed that's most at home in the water, which is perhaps surprising given its nail-biting origins amid a shipwreck.

Today's 'Chessie', as the breed is fondly known, can be traced back to two puppies rescued from a ship that foundered off Maryland, on the east coast of the United States in 1807.

Those two Newfoundland-type dogs - aptly named Sailor and Canton, after the doomed ship - never produced a litter together, but each was mated with other dogs from the nearby Chesapeake Bay area, America's largest estuary.

By 1877, three types of dogs from the shores of the bay were known as Chesapeake Bay Ducking Dogs and were prized by local hunters for their tireless ability to retrieve waterfowl. Three became one in 1918, when the American Kennel Club officially recognised the Chesapeake Bay Retriever.

Though rare all over the world outside of their native Americas, Chessies have called Australia home since 1979, when a NSW couple imported a handsome dog called Buzzard.

"I'd seen photos of this fabulous breed and had read of their outstanding prowess, including competing in the Iditarod Trail race in Alaska.

From there it was just a matter of time until a Chesapeake Bay Retriever came into my life", says Margaret Wedgwood, who adopted Buzzard from his original owners and bred the first live litter of Chessies to be born in Australia.





"A 'ladyfriend' for Buzzard, Dawn, arrived in Australia in early 1983.

In 2015 I'm still breeding with descendants of these original dogs and blending other English, American and New Zealand lines."

#### **Bad hair day?**

Chessies are often mistaken for chocolate Labradors, but are actually larger and stronger and boast an eye-catching wavy coat. (In fact, while Labrador Retrievers are referred to as "the Rolls Royces of the dog world", Chessies are more often compared to Mack trucks).

"His harsh wavy coat looks like a bad perm and makes him unlike any other retriever breed. To some people he is not aesthetically beautiful, but to those of us devoted to the breed everything about this dog has a purpose," says Margaret Wedgwood, from Greenbank in Oueensland.

"This distinctive coat acts as insulation in the water, while his strength of temperament means he never gives up on a retrieve and all he asks as a reward is the approval of the 'boss'."

The headstrong tenacity with which he approaches his retrieving duties sometimes translates to stubbornness. "They are willing and want to please, but they can sometimes be willful and may try to dominate the relationship. Training is definitely required" she explains.

The upside of this stubborn streak is that it's all focused on the Chesapeake Bay Retriever's one true love: his owner.

"Their owners are their life. Some judges demonstrate a lack of knowledge of the Chessie's nature by trying to get the animal's attention in the show ring. He may give the judge a cursory glance, but will always fix his gaze on the face of his best mate on the other end of the lead," says Margaret Wedgwood.

She says she is 'constantly amazed' by the Chessie's apparently instinctive connection to people with disabilities.

"A big, tough Chessie clearly demonstrated this at one show when he was being patted by a group of school children," Margaret recalls.

"He nearly pulled my arm from its socket to go and sit beside a young boy in a wheelchair and push his great head under the lad's hand. How could you not love the big fellow?"

#### A friend for life

As well as his emotional insight, the Chesapeake Bay Retriever is generally a physically robust breed.

Chessies can be susceptible to some inherited diseases, including the eye condition Progressive Retinal Atrophy (PRA), hip dysplasia and degenerative myelopathy, but Margaret Wedgwood says these conditions are virtually non-existent in the Australian population.

"Chessies can also be affected by entropion and ectropion, a genetic condition leading to the turning in or out of the eyelashes," she explains. "It can be remedied by surgery but be careful when selecting a pup as there will be signs from a very young age, including watery, runny eyes."

As with most large dogs, Chessies need plenty of physical and mental exercise to keep them healthy and happy - a daily walk, swim or energetic play session is a must.

And perhaps surprisingly for a dog who's happiest when wet and muddy, Chessies require little grooming. "A good hose down and a stiff brush makes them a 'wash and wear' dog," says Margaret Wedgwood. "But beware - he is always ready to share his muddy/ wet/ smelly body with you. To him it is an act of love."

Muddy paw prints aside, Margaret Wedgwood says Chessies are a lifelong love: once you've welcomed one into your home, you won't ever want to be without one. "What's not to love about this great breed?

From the puppy who looks more like a bear cub than a dog to the gangly teenager trying to get all four legs under control to the magnificent adult, the Chessie is everything you could want in a companion."



## The Large Munsterlander

The Large Munsterlander is a black and white variety of the German Longhaired Pointer. Its ancestors can be traced back to the ninth century, however it was not recognised as a breed in its own right until 1919.

In 1908 the German Longhaired Pointer Club changed the breed standard, specifying that the colour of the dogs should be of a liver variety, thus the Black and White's were excluded. But for a few dedicated black and white owners the breed would not exist today.

In 1919 this group of devotees got together in West Munsterland and named this colour variety the 'Grosse Munsterlander'. The Large Munsterlander was introduced to Australia and recognised by the Australian National Kennel Council in 1983.


#### Personality, characteristics and temperament:

This is an affectionate and energetic breed. Perfect for active individuals or families. They are very loyal and like nothing better than to be with their owners as much as possible. Though they may be left alone at times, they are not a breed to be shut away for long periods.

They make good watch dogs, warning of any trespassers on their territory or protecting their charges whether adults, children or puppies.

They are a naturally clean dog and not destructive, especially if raised with plenty of toys or objects of their own. They are slow to mature and the males often require firmer handling than bitches. They respond very well to positive training, praising being rich reward for doing your bidding.

A highly intelligent breed, they can predict your actions, often reminding you of the time, especially dinner time. They do everything with great enthusiasm!



#### **Care requirements:**

The Large Munsterlander's coat is very low maintenance. It has a medium length coat that lies close to its body, with slightly longer coat on its legs, underside and tail. Their coat is very easy to keep clean, as the dirt drops out when dry. They do require occasional brushing as the longer coat can mat if left unattended.

#### **Ideal owners:**

The Large Munsterlander makes an excellent companion. They are especially suited to active individuals and families. They are especially good with children.

# The Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retriever

The Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retriever, affectionately known as a Toller, is the smallest of the retrieving gundogs. They make up for this with a massive drive, intelligence, personality and willingness to work.

They originated in the 1800s in Nova Scotia, an island off the east coast of Canada however their exact origin is surrounded in myth. It is generally thought that a liver Flat Coat Retriever with possibly Irish Setter and Cocker Spaniel were combined with local farm Collies to produce the breed we see today.

The Collie influence can be seen with some of the "herding traits" noted in the breed today. Although other tolling dogs in Europe(such as the Kooikerhundje) bear a strong resemblance, they are not thought to be in the background of the Toller.

Local Canadian hunters wanted a small agile gundog who was a good swimmer. They also wanted a dog who was strong and capable of carrying a large goose with the ability to handle the marshy terrain in the area . They were also required to play happily on the shoreline or riverbank to attract or lure the birds to within range of the hunter.

The 'Tolling' ability is what sets them apart from other breeds.

This shows in their very animated retrieving style and their showy high tail carriage with an occasional flash (of white feet, chest, tail tip or lighter feathering) to attract the interest of the ducks.

There is a fair amount of misunderstanding regarding colour and markings in the Tollers. There is no requirement for white markings and NO they do not have to have a white tail tip! The standard reads "Various shades of red or orange with lighter featherings and underside of tail, and usuallyat least one of the following white markings , tip of tail, feet (not exceeding beyond the pasterns), chest, and blaze.

A dog of otherwise high quality is not to be penalised for lack of white. The pigment of the nose, lips and eye rims should match, and be flesh-coloured blending with coat, or be black."

The purpose of the white markings, combined with the jaunty attitude and high tail carriage, is to encourage the curious birds to come in for a closer look but white markings are not essential in the art of tolling.

They can be disqualified for too much white, including white on shoulders, around ears, on back of neck, across back or flanks.







The coat can be be any shade of red or orange and this can include maskings/shadings and red sabling but NOT black.

Due to the tollers compact size, agility, strong drive with a biddable nature, they are very versatile across a range of dog sports.

Tollers have excelled in retrieving, agility, obedience, flyball, tracking, lure coursing and dock diving. They have also participated in Search and Rescue and Assistance programmes.

Despite having this incredible drive, they are quite happy to laze around with their owners waiting for their time to run or play so make fantastic pets for an active family.

# The Curly 2 Coated Retriever

Curly Coated Retrievers (Curlies) were bred in England for bird and waterfowl hunting and their temperament and confirmation should reflect their original purpose.

A type of curly was in existence back in the 1600s which has been established from old sketches and paintings and is thought to be the fore-runner of the retrieving dogs.

Curlies were also used by Gamekeepers to pick up game at the end of the days where the curlie's ability to bring back game from a distance and often out of sight of the shooter was invaluable. Their loyalty and faithfulness to their owners was beneficial in assisting gamekeepers to warn off poachers illegally on the estate. The curly is not a barker by nature but having a deep bark is a great deterrent.

Their coat being a mass of dense, tight curls that repels water and burrs gave these dogs protection from heavy vegetation and cold waters. They are known for their tender mouth with both feather and fur and are steady, agile dogs.

Outdoors they are eager and tireless retrievers both on land and water. The Curly was first shown in England in the 1860s in the Retriever class, he was the first Retriever to be shown in England and is believed to be the first of the Retrieving Breeds developed

It has been said the curly has an elegant impressive look about him and they are the tallest of the retrievers.









The breed standard of the Curly demands characteristics of intelligence, steadiness and reliability; with a friendly, self-confident temperament in a dog that may seem aloof at first with strangers when compared to other retrieving breeds.

Being bred for endurance and athleticism in the field they enjoy exercise and love being outside.

Being loyal, steady and reliable they love being with you which makes for a great companion dog but do need the stimulation of outdoor activities as well. Curlies are very independent and though they will sometimes appear aloof with strangers they are generally willing to please and responsive to commands.

Repetitive training can be a chore for these very intelligent animals, wickedly smart comes to mind, so you need to find alternative ways to hold their attention and keep them mentally stimulated.

He is often not totally mature physically until two to three years.

The Curly is an adaptable dog.

They have been used as Assistance, Therapy, Guide dogs, Sniffer dogs, Trekking and the stories go on Curly Coated Retrievers are steady confident dogs and are well suited as Assistance and Therapy dogs. They have been successfully placed as Seeing Guide Dogs, Personal Assistance Dogs and Therapy Dogs in numerous countries around the globe.

Curly Coated Retrievers are used in the United Kingdom and New Zealand as guide dogs for the blind and also in Australia as assistance dogs for medical and physical disabilities.

Curlies are also being used as therapy dogs, visiting patients and residents in hospitals and aged care facilities in Australia.

Curlies are naturally empathetic and will adjust their temperament to their persons mood. They are large dogs able to pull a wheelchair, open doors, and pick up and retrieve items for their charge.

Curlies are retrieving gundogs and this means they are both trainable team members and will also independently use their initiative when required to keep their charge safe.

Curlies are a slightly aloof breed who are more interested in their person than in strangers particularly when they are working. This means they are ideal as service dogs as they will work consistently when out in public.

Positive training methods are used to condition the dogs to blood glucose alerting. Early behavioural moulding (from three weeks) will bring the desired behaviours to the fore and ongoing positive training after the six-week assessment when we identify suitable assistance pups will ensure these traits are retained.

An Assistance Dog also needs to have a very good level of obedience making it a lovely dog to have around at all times.

There are many factors involved in successfully training a dog to be a successful Assistance Dog and all of these are individually fine-tuned to the needs of each human-dog team.

There is a long waiting list for organisation trained dogs at present Australia wide. Cudyncae, Markable and Miamba kennels have all bred assistance dogs.



The dogs pulled a cart containing food and camping equipment. It was necessary for the dogs to wear paw covers as the bitumen sections were particularly difficult.

At the end of the journey none of the dogs showed signs of tiredness or injury. The owner, however, had second thoughts about a repeat performance.

Apart from Showing the Curly has been competing in other dog events such as Obedience, Agility, Rally-O, Dances with Dogs and tracking with some dogs winning and or titled in multiple disciplines throughout the states from our own Queensland to Tasmania.


Currently, I own and exhibit Australian Shepherds, with my partner. We are due to have our first Aussie Shepherd litter in late September.

print in catalogues what you have entered in your dogs' records.

Also, please remember that only valid titles can be used dogs records so some prefixes such as BIS, BISS, RBIS, RBISS cannot be used as these are not valid titles.

It would be a good time to review your records to make sure they are all up to date.


