

Puppy Farming Legislation

Dogs Queensland has been in constant contact with Queensland Government regarding a proposed exemption for its members from the proposed State puppy farming legislation. We are still waiting on the draft of the proposed exemption from government, and we are hopeful that this will come to fruition shortly, so that further discussions on behalf of our members can continue.

Camping at Durack

The Camping Working Party have done a tremendous amount of work at Durack over the last few weeks. The holes that have been popping up around the grounds have been filled and levelled with road base, and other provisions applicable to the camping sites have been fixed. 

APPROVAL OF 2018 NATIONAL SHOW APPLICATION - SHETLAND SHEEPDOG CLUB OF WESTERN AUSTRALIA

ANKC are pleased to advise the approval of the 2018 National Show application received from the Shetland Sheepdog Club of Western Australia via Dogs West to be held on 11th and 12th July 2018 at Dogs West Grounds, Southern River, Western Australia.

RALLY OBEDIENCE RULES - EFFECTIVE 1 JANUARY 2016

As a result of the Board endorsement of the 2015 National Obedience and Tracking Committee meeting minutes we refer all Member Bodies to the following extract (Page 5) from the Rules for the Conduct of Rally Obedience Trials relating to Titles which will be implemented from 1st January 2016. Please note that a numerical RAE Title may be completed in 2016 in accordance with the following:

NOTE: As from the 1st January 2016 the numeric designation to indicate the number of times the dog has met the RAE requirements will cease.

However where a dog has already attained one or more qualifying scores of 80 points or more in both the Rally Advanced B and Rally Excellent B Classes at the same trial towards a numeric designation for a RAE title (eg RAE2) under the former Rules, these qualifications will be accepted towards the required total of five (5) double qualifying scores, provided that at least one double qualifying score of 80 points or more must be attained after these Rules become effective.

TITLES

Only the highest Rally Obedience Title awarded to the dog will be used after the name of the dog or in the case of Rally Champion before the name of the dog. However Rally Advanced Excellent (RAE) and Rally Master (RM) Titles may appear together after the name of the dog. Applications for RN, RA, RE, and RAE titles must be lodged indicating qualifying scores under at least two (2) different Judges.

Applications for RM and RO Ch titles must be lodged indicating qualifying scores under at least three (3) different Judges.

The Member Body will receive applications for the title "Dual Champion" in connection with each dog which, having gained its title of Conformation Ch. and Rally Obedience Champion (R.O. Ch.)

Class Titles and Qualifying Performance:

All dogs eligible to be entered in Rally Obedience Trials in accordance with these Rules shall be eligible to receive Class Title Certificates upon qualification and application.

The Member Body will receive applications for the use of the letters:

R.N. – signifying Rally Novice - Three (3) qualifying scores of 75 points or more must be earned under at least two different Judges in Novice class to earn a title.

R.A. – signifying Rally Advanced - Three (3) qualifying scores of 80 points or more must be earned under at least two different judges in Advanced Class to earn a title.

R.E. – signifying Rally Excellent - Five (5) qualifying scores of 80 points or more must be earned under at least two different Judges in Excellent class to earn a title.

R.A.E. – signifying Rally Advanced Excellent - To qualify for the title of RAE a dog and Handler team must receive a minimum of five (5) qualifying scores, in both the Rally Advanced B and Rally Excellent B Classes at the same trial, of 80 points or more out of a possible perfect score of 100, under at least two different Judges.

However for a period of twelve (12) months from the date when these Rules become effective, where a dog has already attained one or more qualifying scores of 80 points or more in both the Rally Advanced B and Rally Excellent B Classes at the same trial towards a RAE title under the former Rules, these qualifications will be accepted towards the required total of five (5) double qualifying scores, provided that at least one double qualifying score of 80 points or more must be attained after these Rules become effective.

R.M. – signifying Rally Master - Seven (7) qualifying scores of 85 points or more must be earned under at least three different judges in Master class to earn a title.

RO. CH - signifying Rally Obedience Champion - Upon having been granted the Rally Master Title, in order to receive the RO.CH Title, a dog must qualify a further ten (10) times with qualifying scores of 90 or more points in the Rally Master Class under at least (3) different Judges.

ESTRELA MOUNTAIN DOG - ELIGIBILITY FOR EXHIBITION

ANKC confirm the approval by the Board of EM#119 for the recognition of the Estrela Mountain Dog. Full colour coats are not acceptable. Skin should always be pigmented.

To be amended to read:

Colour:

Predominantly white coat with black, tan, blue or liver markings of any shade. Tri colouring is common (i.e., white with black or white with blue or white with liver markings and tan cheeks and/or tan above eyes and/or tan breeches). Brindle markings acceptable but not preferred. Full colour coats are not acceptable. Skin should always be pigmented.

Summer Months – Training

Summer months are a good time for maintenance training your retriever. Hard running retrievers can easily suffer from heat exhaustion so keep training sessions shorter and include water work in your program. Both Retrieving Ability Tests and Novice level Retrieving Trials focus on only sighted retrieves where the dog's performance is basically of its own making and the demand for control is limited to heeling and steadiness.

These summer months are a good time to teach and extend control work especially as too many sighted retrieves can result in the dog becoming excessively independent in attitude.



Make use of this time to drill your dog on basic obedience commands: Sit – Come – Stop – Go and extend your dog's training to include taking casts to Left- Right and Back. Next, build your dog's confidence in running to strategically placed dummies or dummy piles where the dog has not seen anything cast.

A handler can only be said to have control of the retrieve if the dog remains steady, only retrieving when sent in a direction determined by the handler: Furthermore, to have control, a handler must be able to stop the dog with a whistle or voice command and give added directions that are both understood and obeyed.

It is important to keep training drills simple and short and concentrate on each command until it is thoroughly learned and reliably carried out. Slowly build the type of control that will be necessary for your dog to be able to work in the field and retrieve more than one article in a required order including articles that your dog has not seen cast and has no knowledge of where it has fallen. Dogs that have not been taught and thoroughly drilled to run in the direction they are sent will tend to skirt and avoid difficult terrain, cover and water. Start by teaching commands on flat ground with short cover and at short distances.

Only when the dog is performing consistently and reliably should any attempt be made to extend the drills to more difficult terrain, cover and water.

In summer months when the water is warmer is the best time to introduce inexperienced dogs to the discipline of controlled work in water. All dogs can have difficulty maintaining their correct body temperature in oppressive weather conditions.

Make use of water in the hot summer months and train smarter rather than harder.

Summary of the ANKC Ltd Annual General Meeting and Board Meeting held in Victoria on 17th and 18th October, 2015

At the recent Annual General Meeting of the Australian National Kennel Council Limited held in Melbourne:

1. Election of ANKC Ltd Executive

- Mr Hugh Gent OAM was re-elected unopposed as President for a three year term from 17th October 2015;
- Mr Brian Parker was elected as Vice President for a one year term from 17th October 2015; and
- Mr David Sales was re-elected unopposed as Treasurer for a one year term from 17th October 2015.

At the October 2015 ANKC Ltd Board meeting, Directors resolved/ considered the following:

1. ANKC Ltd Officially Registered Canine Health Information Database (ORCHID)

It was resolved for the new health database to be known as the ANKC Ltd Officially Registered Canine Health Information Database (ORCHID).

2. National Breed Councils

It was resolved that the National Breed Council affiliation fee be increased by 20% and that 20% discount be offered to those National Breed Councils that pay their account and submit their financial statements by 30th April each year.

It was resolved that confirmation or notification of any alteration of delegates to attend National Breed Council conferences must be received by the ANKC Ltd Administrator on the relevant National Breed Council letterhead.

3. Estrela Mountain Dog

It was resolved that the eligibility for exhibition of the Estrela Mountain Dog be effective from 1st January 2016.

4. Breed Standard Sketches

It was resolved that ANKC Ltd will not proceed with sourcing sketches for the breed standards on the ANKC Ltd website.

5. Tenterfield Terrier Breed Standard

It was resolved that the request from the National Tenterfield Terrier Council (Australia) to amend the breed standard of the Tenterfield Terrier to read as follows be endorsed:

Colour:

Predominantly white coat with black, tan, blue or liver markings of any shade. Tri colouring is common (i.e., white with black or white with blue or white with liver markings and tan cheeks and/or tan above eyes and/or tan breeches). Brindle markings acceptable but not preferred. Full colour coats are not acceptable. Skin should always be pigmented.

6. Breed Standards - Amendment

It was resolved that in reference to colour, a note be included on any breed standard stating that 'highly undesirable' is to be interpreted as not acceptable for inclusion on the Main Register.

7. Proof of Residency

It was resolved ANKC Ltd recommends all Member Bodies are to insert in their regulations that photographic identification and proof of residency must be provided with all applications for membership and with any change in member details.

8. Display of Membership Number on any Advertisement for Puppies

It was resolved that an ANKC Ltd Member Body Membership Number is to be displayed on any advertisement for puppies whatever the media.

9. Neuter Championship Points System

It was resolved that the award of neuter in group carry the same allocation of points towards neuter titles as this award does for entire animals.

10. Neuter Grand Champion Title

It was resolved that a Grand Champion title be created for Neutered dogs who have achieved 1000 points.

11. *National Judges' Code of Practice and Conduct -Amendment

It was resolved that the National Judges' Code of Practice and Conduct, Clause 16 be amended to read as follows:

16. A Judge must not duplicate assignments in the same breeds and or group within a minimum of 3 months of each other and within a minimum of 200 kilometers at Championship Shows.

12. *National Code of Ethics of Responsible Dog Ownership - Amendment

It was resolved that the National Code of Ethics of Responsible Dog Ownership, Clauses 18 and 26 be amended as follows:

- 18. A member exporting a puppy must comply with all current requirements of the Australian Department of Agriculture.
- 26. A member shall not:
 - 1. Sell or dispose of a dog to a commercial pet wholesaler or retail pet shop.
 - 2. Allow a dog owned by that member to be given as a prize or donation or to be auctioned.

13. * Retrieving Trial Rules - Amendments

It was resolved that Rule 8 be amended by the inclusion of dot point (z) to read as follows:

"(z) A bona fide exhibit is an exhibit where the dog is presented to the judge for competition and cannot be withdrawn except in accordance with Rule 70."

It was resolved that Rule 42 be amended to read:

- 42 (a) In each year there shall be held not more than one (1) Championship Retrieving Trial Stake by each state or territory, except when a state or territory is holding a national Championship it may, in addition, hold a State or Territory Championship.
 - (b) Any state or territory conducting a championship event outside its home state or territory borders shall seek consent from the state or territory **Member Body** in which it proposes to hold the event at least twelve months prior to the proposed event.

Permission should not be unreasonably withheld but the event may not clash with any retrieving trials scheduled by that state or territory.

14. National Drafting Rules - NEW

It was resolved to adopt the new National Drafting Rules to take effect from 1st January 2016. The rules will be available from the ANKC Ltd website.

15. * ANKC Ltd Regulations - Amendments

Amendments to the following regulations have been endorsed.





Labrador Retrievers, first found in Newfoundland, were bred to assist their owners in retrieving hunting game. Their webbed feet, and soft palette which is capable of carrying eggs without breaking them, making them ideal retrievers in marshy areas of Newfoundland and England.

The Labrador Retriever standard says a Labrador should be a short coupled dog, strongly built, broad in the skull, broad and deep in the chest and ribs, broad and strong over the loins and hindquarters and be very active.

They are a very good tempered and agile breed, with an excellent nose, soft mouth and keen love of water. An adaptable and devoted companion that is intelligent with a strong will to please. Labradors have a kindly nature with no trace of aggression or undue shyness.

There are three accepted colours for the Labrador: Black, Yellow or Chocolate, with yellow colourings ranging from a light cream to fox red. Colours should be whole, with a small white spot on the chest permissible. The eyes should be should be brown or hazel, and express intelligence and good temper.

Their movement is described as free, able to cover adequate ground, and is straight and true in front and rear – often described as their ability to reach and drive, a Labrador should be able to spend all day in the field with their owner at a steady pace.



The tail is distinctive, often referred to as an otter tail, which should be thick at the base, gradually tapering to a tip, medium in length, and covered in a short, thick, dense coat all round.

Males should stand between 22 to 22.5 inches tall (56 to 57 cm) and females 21.5 to 22 inches (55 to 56 cm). A relatively healthy breed, the Labrador can suffer from hip and elbow displaysia, with hip and elbow X-Raying recommended before breeding.

Progressive Retinal Atrophy (PRA), is an inherited disorder, with responsible breeders able to prove with DNA testing if the dog is a carrier or clear of the gene. With a lifespan of ten to fifteen years, Labradors are a lifetime investment.

Whilst possibly being one of the most recognisable breeds in the world, the all round versatility of the Labrador is not as obvious for some, with their affectionate and willing to please natures making them immensely trainable, and able to perform a variety of roles from loyal and loving family pet, to guide and assistance dogs, police, military and customs roles, to outstanding dog sports competitors, especially in the areas of Obedience, Retrieving and Tracking.

A SHORT HISTORY ______OF _____ THE BULLMASTIFF BREED

The Bullmastiff was registered first as a new breed in England in 1924, and then in the United States in 1933. Australia imported its first Bullmastiffs prior to the Second World War, although it was subsequent stock that laid the foundation for breeding in Australia.

The Bullmastiff breed, as its name suggests, is a combination of the Old English Mastiff and the British Bulldog.

It was first developed in England in the mid-1800s; the only guarding breed to originate in England. At the time of its creation, there were many large estates in England, the owners of which frowned upon the game in their estates being poached. Gamekeepers were employed to oversee and protect the game in these estates, and they needed an able assistant; the poachers were a dangerous lot since punishment for poaching was hanging. Mastiffs were tried but found to be somewhat slow and lacking the drive necessary to knock down and hold a man.

Bulldogs (a type quite different to the one we see today) were tried, but the bulldog of that era was very ferocious and tended to maul the poacher too much.

So, crosses were made of the Bulldog and Mastiff until a robust ratio of 60% Mastiff, 40% Bulldog was achieved. This dog, eventually named the Bullmastiff, served the needs of the gamekeeper very well.







The dog could track a poacher in the forest at night, work quietly and when close enough, spring to a hard charge, knocking the man down and holding him there until the gamekeeper arrived. This was no mean feat since the poachers used every trick and tool at their disposal to escape, knowing that they faced hanging.

The Bullmastiff had to be very brave and tenacious, and more than one suffered death at the hands of a desperate criminal. But the breed was exactly what the gamekeeper needed and these dogs did their job well. There is a story about one highly trained Bullmastiff named Thorneywood Terror who toured England with his owner putting on demonstrations for crowds.

The owner would muzzle the dog, give a volunteer 10 minutes head start into the forest, and take bets that his dog would stop the man. Thorneywood Terror never failed to catch, bring down and hold his man, and he made a lot of money for his owner.

Tenaciousness (stubbornness if you will) is still a trait of the Bullmastiff breed and makes them a challenge for the novice owner. You absolutely must not let them take an inch, for they will surely make it a mile!

However, they are also docile, easygoing, very loyal and devoted to their family, intelligent, and accepting of strangers welcomed by their owners.

Bullmastiffs are large dogs, although not truly a giant breed. The American Kennel Club standards for the breed call for males to be between 25 and 27 inches at the withers and weigh 50 to 60 kgs. Females should be between 24 and 26 inches at the withers and weigh 45 to 55 kgs.

Only minor differences exist between the American standards and those of the Kennel Club of Great Britain.

Many rescued dogs however are small compared to the standard for the breed. Pedigree Bullmastiffs may be fawn, red or brindle; all having a black mask which covers the muzzle and extends up over the eyes. Brindle is black striping over a base colour of fawn or red.

Brindle was the desired colour of the original dogs used in England, being camouflaged and very hard to see in the forest at night.

As the large estates were broken up and the need for the protective services of Bullmastiffs dwindled they were bred for home and as family companions, and the brindle colour became less popular. Colour is however simply a personal preference, and all good Bullmastiffs are a joy to own. Their coat is short, smooth and easy to groom. Upsides of the Bullmastiff breed are:- Mellow and easygoing; not requiring a great deal of exercise; intelligent; quiet; loyal; good guardians, yet not vicious; sensitive and willing to please.

They take their cue from their owner in a situation, accepting those people their owner accepts, and standing over those people the owner doesn't accept.

Downsides of the breed are:- Short-lived (eight to ten years); slobbery; stubborn (they work on 'bullmastiff-time'); expensive to acquire if buying from a good breeder; can be expensive to maintain.

They have a tendency to specific health problems such as hip dysplasia; elbow dysplasia; interdigital cysts; entropion and ectropion (eyelid problems); and early death from cancer, particularly lymphoma. Pedigree breeders in Australia are required to x-ray the hips and elbows of their breeding pairs to exclude joint dysplasia and reduce the chance of this occurring in the pups.

In placing a Paradigm Bullmastiff pup we look especially for committed family people who have had experience with large breed dogs, but who are not macho types; who have some dog knowledge and common sense, and are willing to learn; who preferably have a house with a fenced yard, but we will consider a responsible person in a townhouse or apartment.







Interestingly, Bullmastiffs do not make bad apartment dogs if the owner is willing to walk them on a leash regularly every day. They do not have a high energy level and are generally quiet dogs.

Bullmastiffs get along well with other animals in their own household when they have been socialised to them early on, but as adults they can be aggressive towards dogs that are strange to them, especially in their own territory.


As with all dogs, thorough early socialisation is essential to having a well-adjusted, congenial pet.

Bullmastiffs need a strong-willed, dominant owner who is consistent in his/her expectations and who can bestow discipline and love equally.



Havanese evolved from various bichon breeds brought from the West Mediterranean by traders and settlers to the West Indies, including Cuba, which was a Spanish colony from Columbus' landing in 1492 until its independence in 1902.

Although the breed has a long existential history, its 'pedigreed'/ Show life is relatively short. The Cuban revolution of the late fifties and early sixties almost resulted in its extinction in its native Havana, and the gene pool of present day Havanese is predominately the result of those Havanese fleeing the revolution with their beloved humans to the USA, with some input from Havanese who found their way to the communist parts of Europe prior to the 1980s.

Havanese were recognised by USA, Canadian and Australian canine authorities in the 1990s, but Crufts 2015 was the first British Show with Championship status, giving Havanese the possibility of attaining a British Championship certificate... so they really are the new kids on the block in that sense.

Havanese are intelligent, friendly, charming, and have a developed sense of humour, however they are completely without guile. On the rare occasion that they are 'naughty' they are the first to 'dob themselves in'.

Almost without exception they are great with kids (and humans of all ages for that matter) and are extensively used as therapy dogs in the USA and Canada. By all accounts, they also excel at Obedience and Agility.



Although long coated, their hair has developed to help (rather than hinder) them to cope with a tropical climate, which makes them a great choice for Queenslanders who want a long haired pet.

Part of their charm is that, while they should always be clean and free of mats, they do not require the 'tizz' of some other toy breeds.

One American site describes them as 'moppy', and our own Dogs Queensland standard says 'All grooming, the usage of scissors to even out the length of the coat, and all trimming is forbidden. Exception: tidying up the hair on the feet is permitted, the hair on the forehead may be slightly shortened so that it does not cover the eyes and the hair on the muzzle may be slightly tidied up, but is preferable to leave it in natural length'.

An added bonus is that they come in all colours of the dog rainbow, so breeding them is, to coin a phrase, 'like a box of chocolates'... you are never quite sure what you will get.

A degree of luck led us to the Havanese, but love and loyalty will keep us together for as long as we are capable of caring for them. We take ours with us everywhere (they are great travellers) and are often asked about them. We always welcome the opportunity acquaint others with this fantastic little breed.

I hope 'Pearl's First Christmas' will provide some insight into the joy and fun of owning a Havanese (or two).

Faithful Companian The Maremma Sheepdog

The Maremma is a very loyal and faithful companion to its owner. I say owner rather than master, as you will never become the master of a Maremma Sheepdog, only its equal. The Maremma accepts the leadership of humans but not their mastery. While being a good friend they will not willingly be your slave.

The 'Maremma Sheepdog' is believed to have evolved from the large white dogs of central Europe who were mentioned in Roman writings as far back as 116BC. They have been used in Italy for some 2000 years to protect the flocks and property of shepherds from predators such as wolves, bears, stray dogs and thieves.

The Maremma Sheepdog occupied two separate locations in Italy, the Abruzzi region of the Apennine Mountains in the summer and the plains of Maremma in the winter. They are known in Italy today as the Cane da pastore Maremmano-Abruzzese. The Maremma was introduced into Australia in approximately 1982 and used extensively as a Livestock Guardian Dog (LGD) in Australia, New Zealand, United States and Canada.

The Maremma is classed as a medium to large breed of imposing presence and majestic bearing, with their size accentuated when in full coat. For their size they are very flexible and able to turn on the spot.



The temperament of the Maremma is generally a reserved animal wary of strangers. Its attitude is determined by the abilities of the owner, the wisdom of the breeder in selecting complementary pedigrees when deciding to have a litter and the handling and care of the pups in the first few weeks of their life. They are constantly aware of their responsibility and will see a threat in any strange object, being or footfall.

They will not attack without provocation preferring to warn strangers away with a bark especially at night-time but trespassing is not taken lightly. Nonetheless he is affectionate to his owners. Old friends are accepted but the Maremma will usually remain on duty during their presence.

Strangers are not welcome and the dog should be under control when irregular callers are admitted. A 'FORMAL' introduction, best made when the caller has been admitted and is seated usually suffices to satisfy the dog that there is no danger but do remember that he makes his own judgements and may suspect danger where you see none.

Over the centuries the Maremma has developed a very strong guarding instinct and responsibility for taking decisions as they were frequently left by the shepherds in sole charge.







The independence required for solitary guarding makes the Maremma sometimes unwillingly to take orders.

This protective instinct has proved to be quite adaptable but training is required. Several trials and studies have been done in Australia as LGDs.

A Biosecurity Queensland study has confirmed that guardian dogs like the Maremma could provide an answer to wild dog problems in the Ipswich region.

Trials have been successfully held on Middle Island to protect the Penguins and an Australian movie has been made called 'Oddball' based on the true story of Swamp Marsh, a Victorian chook farmer whose ideas of using dogs to protect the penguins saved an entire colony.

Zoos Victoria is also involved in a program training Maremma's to protect the bandicoots.

The Great Sandy Desert

Five dogs took part in our trials in The Great Sandy Desert, to remove Dingoes from mining camps in the desert. We conducted two trials over a twelve month period.



Trial 1. For NewCrest Mining Company at their Gold Mining Operation at Telfer involving four dogs.

Trial 2. For Nifty Berla at their Copper Operations, some 100 kms south of Telfer, involving one dog ('Moses'). The heat factor was our biggest obstacle in The Great Sandy Desert, which was a constant 47 degrees throughout the trial.

The Maremma has done well in the show ring campaigned by John and Audrey Jamieson competing and winning at many Royals throughout Australia with their dogs.

Also Wendy Nash had much success with training several dogs 'Piltanga Panda' AD JD who was the first Maremma Sheepdog with AD JD titles and 'Piltanga Twilight Blaze' as a competitive Agility and Jumping Dog as well as being a Pet Assisted Therapy Dog at Mater Childrens Hospital, Brisbane.

As a show dog they are late developers before you will see the best of them. Needing to be lithe and flexible to spring to at a moment's notice means a juvenile's movement does look different. It is strongly recommended that you see Adult dogs in their home environment before you purchase so that you can see their true size, temperament and meet these wonderful dogs.



They are not for everyone as they have a mind of their own and are not blindly obedient.

This is an aspect that lovers of Maremma's find attractive, being a 'thinking' dog but they are not suitable for everyone or the inexperienced. They are courageous without being aggressive but need to be socialised.

It must be appreciated that the Maremma is a 'Protection Dog' and once bonded to a particular situation, be it livestock guard, family pet or show dog. it is very reluctant to transfer allegiance and so is difficult to rehome.

Owners should also be aware that the natural instinct of this breed is to protect and so will react to any perceived threat to its charges be they family members, their property or the stock that they are bonded to.

This breed is only suitable as a family pet/companion dog where the owners are prepared to give it regular exercise and not leave it for long periods without company. They must have some form of activity to occupy its time or it will quickly become bored and this will result in destructive behavior and excessive barking.







An accolade goes to John and Audrey Jamieson who have been true champions of the breed since they obtained their first Maremma to assist them in looking after their goats, travelling throughout Queensland and interstate to dog shows to compete against other Maremma's and promote the breed to the public. They also have given their time at many Farm fests, show training and other events.

I am a relative newbie to this breed as having only owned a Maremma myself for the past 6 years, but I am still being amazed at things they do as I see firsthand their instinctive nature coming out as various scenarios unfold.

They are a truly wonderful breed but must be treated with the respect they deserve for their true nature and instinct. With the correct breeding and socialisation they should not be an aggressive dog.

Every night when we come home we are greated with the greatest smile from our beautiful girl 'Lady' (her eyes light up and teeth are shown in the widest grin). What more can you ask for in a welcome home.

A tip for the unwary. The traits you love them for can be your undoing. If you are running late and in a rush to leave the house, don't leave the dog to the last minute.

Running out the door this morning late I find my loving loyal very intelligent friend has picked up on my 'stressed mood' and decided to 'assess' the situation for herself refusing to come to the mad woman rushing about calling her. Makes sense! Motto - 'Calm and collected wins the day'.

While my non-doggy friends thought I was mad (but could appreciate the gorgeous pics) most of my dog world friends have asked where they can get the same.


