- 1) Dog's owner to nominate up to 10 qualifying scores from January to November each year.
- 2) Dog's owner/s must reside in Queensland, be financial members of Dogs Queensland, and the dog must reside in Queensland and be registered with Dogs Australia.
- 3) Scores from all Sighthound and Coursing Ability Classes may be included (excluding Junior Courser).
- 4) Must include scores from at least 3 different Judges.
- 5) Maximum of 1 score gained at interstate trials may be included. Copies of interstate certificates must be provided for verification.
- 6) All scores must be a passing/qualifying score for that Class.
- 7) Form **must** be returned by the 31st of December.

#### **Title Awards**

Each year the DogsQLD Lure Coursing Subcommittee award dogs who have achieved a Lure Coursing Title throughout the year. The eligible titles are listed below.

#### Sighthounds

Open Stakes - Field Champion (FCH), Lure Courser of Merit (LCM), Lure Courser Excellent (LCX) Veteran Stakes - Veteran Field Champion (vFCH), Veteran Lure Courser of Merit (vLCM), Veteran Lure Courser Excellent (vLCX)

Single Stakes - Singles Lure Courser of Merit (sLCM), Singles Lure Courser Excellent (sLCX)

## Coursing Ability

All Dogs - Coursing Ability Advanced (CAA), Coursing Ability Excellent (CAX), Coursing Ability Master (CAM).

To apply for a Title Award, you will be required to send through your dogs Title Certificate to the DogsQLD Lure Coursing Subcommittee before the 31st of December each year.

The Title Awards will be presented at the DogsQLD Lure Coursing Subcommittee Annual Awards Presentation (separate to the DogsQLD Dog Sports Award Presentation).
