5. Completed forms must be returned by the 31st of December each year.

Singles Lure Courser Excellent (sLCX)

Coursing Ability

All Dogs – Coursing Ability Advanced (CAA), Coursing Ability Excellent (CAX),
Coursing Ability Master (CAM).

To apply for a Title Award, you will be required to send through your dog's Title Certificate to the Dogs QLD Lure Coursing Subcommittee before the 31st of December each year.
