The Judges Training Program is conducted under Dogs Australia Regulations and is a national scheme. The ANKC Rules for the Conduct of SprintDog™ can be downloaded from the Dogs Australia Rules website: https://dogsaustralia.org.au/media/10326/23-da-sprintdog-rules_01-07-24v2.pdf

The welfare of dogs competing in SprintDog™ and the safety of handlers, officials and the public is paramount to our sport and must always be given highest priority.

ELIGIBILITY IN THE SPRINTDOG™ JUDGES TRAINING PROGRAM

Application Procedure.

All applications for entry into the Training Program must be on the nominated form and be received before the nominated date.

To be eligible to enter the Program the applicant must:

- have been a member of the ANKC Ltd Member Body for a total period of not less than three (3) years, but dispensation may be given for persons with sufficient experience in this discipline.
- be over eighteen (18) years of age.
- be approved by the Member Body.
- have experience in related Club or training activities, or other ANKC disciplines.
- be physically capable of judging and operating a lure machine in accordance with the SprintDog™ Rules.
- trained and trialed a dog to the Novice SprintDog title.
- acted as an Official for a minimum of five (5) SprintDog™ Events.

Eligibility to Judge or operate a Lure Machine at a SprintDog™ Event.

The only persons eligible to judge SprintDog™ Events shall be Dogs Australia SprintDog™ Judges.

The only persons eligible to operate a lure machine at SprintDog™ Events shall be Dogs Australia Approved SprintDog™ Lure Operators and trainees enrolled in the Dogs QLD SprintDog™ training program.

The Training Program.

Once the SprintDog™ Committee has received your application, you will be sent information about the training program and a logbook.

The logbook is used by trainees to record evidence of any activity which is a requirement of the scheme, including:

- attending lectures and /or other advertised instruction sessions provided by the SprintDog™ Committee.
- attending Practical Training sessions.
- acting as an official at ANKC recognised SprintDog™ Events.

Trainees will also be required to educate themselves by studying the ANKC Rules for the Conduct of SprintDog™ Events as well as the relevant Dogs Queensland Regulations.

As evidence of having fulfilled the necessary requirements, the applicant must provide the completed logbook to the SprintDog™ Committee for approval prior to applying for the final assessments.
