Dogs Queensland expects all Affiliated Clubs to adhere to the following:

1.5 Special provisions Lure Coursing and SprintDog.

An event which involves a dog pursuing a lure must not continue when the average temperature is greater than 30 degrees Celsius. The Affiliate must have a thermometer available at the event that can accurately measure temperature. The average temperature is calculated by adding the temperature at an unshaded area (ideally a section of where the lure is chased) and the temperature in the shade, and then divided by two. If the average temperature is greater than 30 degrees Celsius the event must either be postponed for 30 minutes or concluded. If after 30 minutes, the average temperature drops below 30 degrees Celsius, the event can resume.

TRACK DESIGN AND DOG SAFETY

The accountabilities set out below have been established to ensure track design used in this event allows for the safest and fairest conditions for all competitors taking part and follows the rules of Dogs Australia.

- ❖ The Sprint Zone is the area that contains the Start Box, Sprint Area and Catching Pen.
- ❖ The Sprint Zone must be the following lengths:
 - Start Box – 3 metres with sufficient room for a dog's body behind the back of the start box. (1m is sufficient)
 - Sprint Area – 100 metres
 - Catching Pen – minimum 30 metres (if return to handler track is being used the pulley must be placed 50 metres past the finish line)
 - Exclusion Zones – minimum 10 metres
- ❖ The lure line must be securely anchored to the ground to minimize the risk of dogs becoming entangled by the line with the exception of a Drag Lure Setup.
- ❖ The lure may contain a squawker in the case of a Drag Lure System. The Lure must be of artificial nature and be suited to the machine. In the case of Continuous Loop System, the lure must be odourless plastic or fabric of high contrast to the surrounding environment. A maximum of two Lures may be used. They must be of the same type.
- ❖ The Sprint Zone is a NO GO ZONE to all competitors and spectators other than those competing at the time. *

* The only exceptions to the NO GO ZONE are Photographers and Trainees. Trial Manager and Judge must approve exceptions.

These conditions are set out as minimum requirements and were developed by the SprintDog™ Subcommittee and will be the accountability of the Event Manager to ensure compliance.
