## Veterinary Certificate of Soundness

As per Clause (1) under "INSPECTION" of the Dogs Australia Rules for the Conduct of Endurance Tests (Effective from 1 January 2024); A Veterinary Certificate, issued within fourteen (14) days immediately prior to the date of the test, must be submitted for each dog on the day of the Test. It shall cover such things as the general fitness, temperature, standing heart rate, condition of the pads and muscle tone of the dog. (For bitches, the certificate is to state also that the bitch is not in whelp).

An Endurance Test consists of a 20km run/ride at an average speed of 10kph. It is completed in three legs: 1 x 8km with a 15-minute rest period plus Vet check, 1 x 6km with a 20-minute rest period plus Vet check, finishing with a 1 x 6km and 15-minute rest period. At the end of the final rest period the fourth veterinary check shall be undertaken followed by a willingness test. A Willingness Test will be given prior to the commencement of the Test. The following information is required by the Owner within 14 days of the Test date and is to be handed to the Trial Secretary prior to the pre-test Vet check on the day of the Test.
